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AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING OR REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES, EXPANDING OR CHANGING PURPOSES, EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIODS, CHANGING AGENCIES AND ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OR TRANSFER OF UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY THE LEGISLATURE IN PRIOR YEARS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--REVERSION OF

PROCEEDS.--

A. Except as otherwise provided in another section of this act:

(1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund:

(a) at the end of the expenditure period as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed in this act; or

(b) if the expenditure period is not changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in the law that originally authorized the severance tax bonds or the time frame set forth in any law that has previously reauthorized the expenditure of the proceeds, whichever is

1 later; and

2 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds
3 of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
4 reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
5 bonding fund three months after the reversion date for the
6 unexpended balances.

7 B. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
8 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
9 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
10 written obligations to third parties.

11 SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--
12 REVERSIONS.--

13 A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
14 of this act:

15 (1) the unexpended balance of an
16 appropriation from the general fund or other state fund that
17 has been changed in this act shall revert:

18 (a) at the end of the expenditure
19 period as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is
20 changed in this act; or

21 (b) if the expenditure period is not
22 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
23 the law in which the original appropriation was made or the
24 time frame set forth in any law that has previously changed
25 the appropriation, whichever is later; and

1 (2) all remaining balances of an
2 appropriation from the general fund or other state fund that
3 has been changed in this act shall revert three months after
4 the reversion date for the unexpended balance.

5 B. Except as provided in Subsection C of this
6 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the
7 general fund or other state fund shall revert pursuant to
8 Subsection A of this section to the originating fund.

9 C. The balance of an appropriation made from the
10 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs
11 department or the aging and long-term services department for
12 a project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or
13 pueblo shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section
14 to the tribal infrastructure project fund.

15 D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
16 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
17 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
18 written obligations to third parties.

19 SECTION 3. PASEO DEL VOLCAN LOOP BYPASS ROAD
20 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO PASEO DEL VOLCAN CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND
21 TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
22 appropriation to the department of transportation originally
23 authorized in Subsection 57 of Section 25 of Chapter 66 of
24 Laws 2014 to acquire rights of way for and to plan, design
25 and construct paseo del Volcan loop bypass road from Unser

1 boulevard to interstate 40 in Bernalillo and Sandoval
2 counties and reauthorized in Laws 2018, Chapter 68, Section 3
3 and for which the time of expenditure was extended in Laws
4 2020, Chapter 82, Section 3 shall not be expended for the
5 original purpose but is changed to acquire rights of way for
6 and to plan, design and construct paseo del Volcan in
7 Bernalillo and Sandoval counties. The time of expenditure
8 is extended through fiscal year 2024.

9 SECTION 4. PASEO DEL VOLCAN CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--
10 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the
11 department of transportation project in Subsection 1 of
12 Section 32 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to acquire rights of
13 way and to design and construct paseo del Volcan, also known
14 as New Mexico highway 347, in Sandoval and Bernalillo
15 counties is extended through fiscal year 2024.

16 SECTION 5. PASEO DEL VOLCAN RIGHTS OF WAY ACQUISITION
17 AND CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time
18 of expenditure for the department of transportation project
19 in Subsection 1 of Section 24 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to
20 acquire rights of way and to design and construct paseo del
21 Volcan, also known as New Mexico highway 347, in Sandoval and
22 Bernalillo counties and for which the time of expenditure was
23 extended in Laws 2020, Chapter 82, Section 4 is extended
24 through fiscal year 2024.

25 SECTION 6. PASEO DEL VOLCAN RIGHTS OF WAY ACQUISITION--

1 CHANGE TO PASEO DEL VOLCAN CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--
2 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
3 appropriation to the department of transportation in
4 Subsection 61 of Section 24 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to
5 purchase rights of way for paseo del Volcan from Unser
6 boulevard to the Bernalillo-Sandoval county line and for
7 which the time of expenditure was extended in Laws 2020,

11 Sandoval counties. The time of expenditure is extended
12 through fiscal year 2024.

20 Senator Dennis Chavez boulevard and to 118th street, in
21 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county and reauthorized in Laws
22 2020, Chapter 82, Section 16 to include sidewalks and signal
23 modifications is extended through fiscal year 2024.

24 SECTION 8. BERNALILLO COUNTY FAMILY SERVICES FACILITIES
25 IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of

1 expenditure for the local government division project in
2 Subsection 53 of Section 26 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to

5 services facility site in the South Valley in Bernalillo
6 county and to purchase and install teleconferencing and
7 information technology equipment at facility sites in the

9 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2024.

10 SECTION 9. BERNALILLO COUNTY HOMELESS FACILITY SHOWERS
11 AND LAUNDRY CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS--
12 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
13 appropriation to the local government division project in
14 Subsection 7 of Section 29 of Chapter 138 of Laws 2021 to
15 plan, design, construct, purchase, furnish, equip and install
16 accessible showers and laundry services for a facility
17 serving the homeless in Bernalillo county shall not be
18 expended for the original purpose but is changed to plan,
19 design, purchase, install, equip and furnish a facility,
20 including information technology and related furniture,
21 equipment and infrastructure, white goods and vehicles, for
22 an agency providing services to the homeless in Bernalillo
23 county.
