11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY
12 SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK TO RESEARCH, DESIGN AND IMPLEMENT A PILOT
13 PROJECT TO REDUCE EARLY COURT INTERVENTION FOR AT-RISK YOUTH IN
14 DONA ANA COUNTY; REQUIRING REPORTS.

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16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Seventy-five thousand dollars
18 (\$75,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of
19 regents of New Mexico state university for expenditure in
20 fiscal years 2015 and 2016 for the school of social work to
21 research, design and implement a pilot project to reduce early
22 court intervention for at-risk youth in Dona Ana county. After
23 receiving the appropriated funds, the school of social work
24 shall report to the interim legislative health and human
25 services committee once during each of the fiscal year 2015 and

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1 2016 interims. The reports shall inform the interim committee
2 on the research, progress and outcomes related to the pilot
3 project. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at
4 the end of fiscal year 2016 shall revert to the general fund.

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
