AN ACT

RELATING TO LIVESTOCK; AMENDING THE INJURY TO LIVESTOCK SECTION TO REQUIRE SUBMISSION OF RECORDINGS OF INJURIES TO LIVESTOCK TO A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 30-18-12 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1998, Chapter 35, Section 1) is amended to read:

"30-18-12. INJURY TO LIVESTOCK.--

- A. Injury to livestock consists of willfully and maliciously poisoning, killing or injuring livestock that is the property of another.
- B. As used in this section, "livestock" means cattle, sheep, buffalo, horses, mules, goats, swine and ratites.
- C. Whoever commits injury to livestock is guilty of .199017.1

a fourth degree felony.

D. A person who has made a video or digital recording shall submit the recording to a law enforcement agency within twenty-four hours of determining or having reason to believe that it depicts injury to livestock. It is prohibited to splice, edit or otherwise alter a video or digital recording prior to its submission to a law enforcement agency pursuant to this section.

E. Whoever commits a violation of Subsection D of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor."

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2015.
