AN ACT
RELATING TO PUBLIC WATERS; AMENDING A SECTION OF CHAPTER 17
NMSA 1978; DEFINING THE SCOPE OF EASEMENT CREATED BY
CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISIONS REGARDING OWNERSHIP OF PUBLIC
WATERS, BENEFICIAL USE OF PUBLIC WATERS AND THE RIGHT TO
ACQUIRE, OWN AND PROTECT PRIVATE PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR
LAWFUL RECREATIONAL ACCESS TO PUBLIC WATERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 17-4-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1912,
Chapter 85, Section 10, as amended) is amended to read:

"17-4-6. HUNTING AND FISHING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY--
POSTING--PENALTY.--

A. Whenever the owner or lessee desires to protect
or propagate game birds, animals or fish within the owner's
or lessee's enclosure or pasture, the owner or lessee shall
publish notices in English and Spanish warning all persons
not to hunt or fish within the enclosure or pasture. The
notices shall be posted in at least six conspicuous places on
the premises and published for three consecutive weeks in a
newspaper of general circulation in the county where the
premises are situated. In the event a public road enters or
crosses the enclosure or pasture, an additional notice shall
be posted conspicuously within three hundred yards of the
point where each public road enters the posted property.

B. After the publication and posting, it is a
misdemeanor for any person to enter the premises for the
