RELATING TO CHILD CARE; PROVIDING EXEMPTION FROM STATE
LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR CHILD CARE PROGRAMS OR FACILITIES
LICENSED OR CERTIFIED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
DEFENSE AND THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

FACILITIES--MILITARY FACILITIES.--A program or a facility certified as a family child care provider by a branch of the United States department of defense or by the United States coast guard shall be exempt from child care facility licensure requirements provided pursuant to state law. This section does not apply to family child care providers who also provide child care services to children not affiliated with a branch of the United States department of defense or the United States coast
