15	SECTION 1. Section 72-2-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1907,
16	Chapter 49, Section 4, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"72-2-1. APPOINTMENTREMOVALQUALIFICATIONSDUTIES
18	OFFICEPRIVATE PRACTICE PROHIBITEDThere shall be a "state
19	engineer" who shall be a technically qualified and registered
20	professional engineer under the Engineering and [Land]
21	Surveying Practice Act and a licensed New Mexico attorney with
22	water law experience and shall be appointed by the governor and
23	confirmed by the senate. [He] <u>The state engineer</u> shall hold
24	office for the term of two years or until [his] <u>a</u> successor has
25	been appointed and has qualified. [He] <u>The state engineer</u> is

1	subject to removal only for cause. [He] <u>The state engineer</u> has
2	general supervision of waters of the state and of the
3	measurement, appropriation, distribution thereof and such other
4	duties as required. The salary of the state engineer shall be
5	set by the governor, and [he] <u>the state engineer</u> shall receive
6	necessary traveling expenses while away from [his] <u>the</u> office
7	of the state engineer in the discharge of official duties
8	pursuant to the provisions of the Per Diem and Mileage Act.
9	The "office of the state engineer" shall be located at the seat
10	of government. [He] <u>The state engineer</u> shall not engage in any
11	private practice."
12	SECTION 2. APPLICABILITYThe provisions of this act
13	apply to a state engineer appointed on or after January 1,
14	2019.
