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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
19	SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 2, Article 3 NMSA
20	1978 is enacted to read:

23	A. The New Mexico legislative council shall direct
24	the legislative council service to develop and implement an

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1 technical revision of the statutes on an annual basis. 2 Β. Prior to January 1 of each year, the director of 3 the legislative council service shall make available to the New 4 Mexico legislative council draft legislation and a report. 5 C. The draft legislation shall revise statutes with technical issues to make them more clear, accessible and 6 7 usable, but shall not alter a statute's meaning, effect, policy 8 or purpose. 9 D. The report shall: 10 summarize the changes made by the draft (1)11 legislation; 12 identify statutes requiring technical (2) 13 revisions that cannot be made without altering the statute's 14 meaning, effect, policy or purpose; and 15 (3) provide an overall plan for systematic 16 statutory revision and a progress update. 17 The position of "revisor of statutes" is created Ε. 18 in the legislative council service to report to and serve at 19 the pleasure of the director of the legislative council 20 service. 21 The revisor of statutes shall: F. 22 carry out the provisions of this section (1) 23 by preparing the draft legislation and report; 24 develop a systematic plan to study and (2) 25 revise all statutory sections; .223537.1 - 2 -

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1 address matters the New Mexico legislative (3) 2 council deems necessary; 3 (4) perform other duties assigned by the 4 director of the legislative council service; and (5) 5 consult with the New Mexico compilation 6 commission to ensure the clarity, organization and 7 accessibility of the statutes." 8 Section 2-3-8 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1951, SECTION 2. 9 Chapter 182, Section 4, as amended) is amended to read: 10 "2-3-8. PURPOSE AND DUTIES OF LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 11 SERVICE.--The [purpose and duties of the] legislative council 12 service shall: [be: 13 a. to] A. assist the legislature [of the State of 14 New Mexico] in the proper performance of its constitutional 15 functions by providing its members with impartial and accurate 16 information and reports concerning the legislative problems 17 [which] that come before them and by providing digests showing 18 the practices of other states and foreign nations in dealing 19 with similar problems; 20 [b.] B. when [so] requested, [to] secure 21 information for and [to] report to the legislators of this 22 state on the social and economic effects of statutes of this 23 state or elsewhere by cooperating with the legislative service 24 agencies in other states and other reference agencies and 25 libraries;

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1 [c. to] C. furnish to the members of the 2 legislature [of this state] the assistance of expert 3 [draftsmen] drafters qualified to aid the legislators in the preparation of bills for introduction into the legislature; 4 5 [d. to] D. recommend to the legislature measures 6 [which] that will improve the form and working of the statutes 7 [of this state] and clarify and reconcile their provisions, including through the statutory revision program; 8 9 [e. to] E. provide for the legislature adequate 10 staff facilities and [to provide the adequate] expert 11 assistance [without which no] necessary for the legislature 12 [can] to properly perform its required functions; and 13 [f. to] F. prepare and index for printing as 14 promptly as possible after the adjournment of each session the 15 session laws [therefor, which] as a compilation that shall 16 include all resolutions and acts [which] the legislature [has] 17 adopted or passed during the session and [have] that received 18 the approval of the governor when such approval is necessary." 19 SECTION 3. Section 12-1-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1977, 20 Chapter 74, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read: 21 "12-1-3. POWERS OF COMMISSION. -- The New Mexico 22 compilation commission, acting on the advice and approval of an 23 advisory committee appointed by the New Mexico supreme court, 24 which shall include the revisor of statutes of the legislative 25 council service, may: .223537.1

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1 provide for official, annotated compilations of Α. 2 the New Mexico statutes and court rules as approved by the 3 supreme court and all other necessary things pertaining to the publication, including online publication, of any compilation 4 5 and related publications; 6 Β. provide for the licensing of the content of the 7 compilation and any related publications; 8 contract with a publisher for any compilation or C. 9 related publications as may be necessary or desirable to carry 10 out the provisions of this section; 11 D. do all things necessary to keep current the 12 master database of publications published or authorized for 13 publication by the compilation commission; and 14 Ε. hire an executive director, who shall: 15 serve as the chief administrative officer (1)16 of the commission; 17 serve at the pleasure of the commission; (2) 18 carry out the policies established by the (3) 19 commission; and 20 within available funding, hire such (4) 21 additional staff as necessary to effectuate the powers 22 exercised by the commission." 23 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thirty thousand 24 dollars (\$130,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the 25 legislative council service for expenditure in fiscal year 2024 .223537.1 - 5 -
