10 AN ACT

11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO PROVIDE  
12 HEALTH CARE WORKERS STATEWIDE WITH TRAINING ON AND TECHNICAL  
13 ASSISTANCE FOR THE EARLY DETECTION OF RISK FOR CEREBRAL PALSY  
14 IN YOUNG CHILDREN.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred thousand dollars  
18 (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the  
19 department of health for expenditure in fiscal years 2022 and  
20 2023 to fund the family, infant, toddler program's provision of  
21 training for and technical assistance to health care workers  
22 statewide for the early detection of risk for cerebral palsy in  
23 young children. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance  
24 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2023 shall revert to the  
25 general fund.
