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AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LEGISLATURE; ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES TO FILL A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF REPRESENTATIVE AND IN THE OFFICE OF SENATOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 2-7F-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2021 (2nd S.S.), Chapter 6, Section 4) is amended to read:

"2-7F-4. ELECTIONS--VACANCIES.--

- Members of the house of representatives shall be elected for terms of two years.
- If a vacancy occurs in the office of representative for any reason, the vacancy shall be filled as follows:
- for a representative district that is (1) situated wholly within the exterior boundaries of a single .223582.3

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county, the board of county commissioners of that county shal	.1
appoint the representative to fill the vacancy <u>following the</u>	
procedures of Subsections C and D of this section; and	

- for a representative district situated within two or more counties:
- (a) the board of county commissioners of each county in the representative district shall submit one name to the governor; and
- (b) the governor shall appoint the representative to fill the vacancy from the list of names so submitted.
- C. Except as provided in Subsection D of this section, when a board of county commissioners is required to fill a vacancy in the house of representatives by appointment, the board shall:
- (1) solicit and accept applications immediately following the vacancy;
- (2) hold a special meeting within three weeks of the vacancy, at which the board shall make the appointment using ranked-choice voting, to be administered by the county clerk, who shall make the ballots publicly available; and
- (3) announce the date of the special meeting within two business days of the vacancy.
- D. If a vacancy occurs during a legislative session, the board shall solicit and accept applications .223582.3

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immediately following the vacancy and appoint a successor within five business days of the vacancy using ranked-choice voting, to be administered by the county clerk, who shall make the ballots <u>publicly available</u>.

- [C.] E. An appointment to fill a vacancy in the house of representatives shall be for a term ending on December 31 after the next general election.
- [D. An appointment to fill a vacancy made before the general election of 2022 shall be made from the district as it was described in Section 2-7E-1 NMSA 1978, as established by the court in Egolf v. Duran, D-101-CV-2011-02942 (1st Dist. Ct., Judgment and Final Order on Remand (State House of Representatives Trial) filed February 28, 2012).] F. On or after the general election of 2022, a vacancy shall be filled by appointment from the district as set out in the 2021 House Redistricting Act."
- SECTION 2. Section 2-8F-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2021 (2nd S.S.), Chapter 7, Section 4) is amended to read:
 - "2-8F-4. ELECTIONS--VACANCIES.--
- Members of the senate shall be elected for terms of four years.
- If a vacancy occurs in the office of senator for В. any reason, the vacancy shall be filled as follows:
- (1) for a senate district that is situated wholly within the exterior boundaries of a single county, the .223582.3

- (2) for a senate district situated within two or more counties:
- (a) the board of county commissioners of each county in the senate district shall submit one name to the governor; and
- (b) the governor shall appoint the senator to fill the vacancy from the list of names so submitted.
- C. Except as provided in Subsection D of this section, when a board of county commissioners is required to fill a legislative office vacancy by appointment, the board shall:

(1) solicit and accept applications immediately following the vacancy;

- (2) hold a special meeting within three weeks of the vacancy, at which the board shall make the appointment using ranked-choice voting, to be administered by the county clerk, who shall make the ballots publicly available; and
- (3) announce the date of the special meeting within two business days of the vacancy.
- D. If a vacancy occurs during a legislative session, the board shall solicit and accept applications .223582.3

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immediately following the vacancy and appoint a successor within five business days of the vacancy using ranked-choice voting, to be administered by the county clerk, who shall make the ballots publicly available.

[G.] E. All appointments to fill vacancies in the senate shall be for a term ending on December 31 [subsequent to] after the next succeeding general election, at which general election a person shall be elected to fill the remainder of any unexpired term.

[Đ-] F. An appointment to fill a vacancy made before the general election of 2024 shall be made from the district as it was described in Section 2-8E-1 NMSA 1978, as established by the court in *Egolf v. Duran*, D-101-CV-2011-02942 (1st Dist. Ct., Judgement and Final Order (State Senate Trial) filed January 25, 2012). On or after the general election of 2024, a vacancy shall be filled by appointment from the district as set out in the 2021 Senate Redistricting Act."

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
