RELOCATION PAYMENTS.--11 Whenever a program or project undertaken by an Α. 12 agency will result in the displacement of a person, the 13 displacing agency shall provide for payment to the displaced 14 person for: 15 (1) actual reasonable expenses in moving the 16 person or the person's family, business, farm operation or 17 other personal property; 18 (2) actual direct losses of tangible 19 personal property as a result of moving or discontinuing a 20 business or farm operation, but not to exceed an amount equal 21 to the reasonable expenses that would have been required to 22 relocate the property, as determined by the displacing 23 agency; 24 (3) actual reasonable expenses in searching 25 for a replacement business or farm, supported by documentation that the displacing agency by regulation may
