AN ACT
RELATING TO PROCUREMENT; PERMITTING A DESIGNEE OF THE
DIRECTOR OF THE FACILITIES MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE GENERAL
SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO SERVE ON AN ARCHITECT, ENGINEER,
LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT AND SURVEYOR SELECTION COMMITTEE AND
REQUIRING SERVICE WITHOUT SUBSTITUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 13-1-121 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1984,
Chapter 65, Section 94, as amended) is amended to read:

"13-1-121. COMPETITIVE SEALED QUALIFICATIONS-BASED
PROPOSALS--ARCHITECTS--ENGINEERS--LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS--
SURVEYORS--SELECTION COMMITTEE--STATE PUBLIC WORKS
PROJECTS.--

A. For each state public works project, an
"architect, engineer, landscape architect and surveyor
selection committee" shall be formed with four members as
follows:

(1) one member of the agency for which the
project is being designed;

(2) the director of the facilities
management division of the general services department, or
the director's designee, who shall be chair;

(3) one member designated by the joint
practice committee; and

(4) one member designated by the secretary.
