11 RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; CREATING THE ADJUNCT INSTRUCTORS
12 ACT; ALLOWING THE CERTIFICATION AND CONTRACTING OF ADJUNCT
13 INSTRUCTORS; REQUIRING BACKGROUND CHECKS AND EXCLUDING OTHER
14 SCHOOL PERSONNEL ACT PROVISIONS.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 SECTION 1. A new section of the Public School Code is
18 enacted to read:

19 "[NEW MATERIAL] SHORT TITLE.--This act may be cited as the
20 "Adjunct Instructors Act"."

21 SECTION 2. A new section of the Public School Code is
22 enacted to read:

23 "[NEW MATERIAL] DEFINITIONS.--As used in the Adjunct
24 Instructors Act:

25 A. "adjunct instructor" means a person who:

1 (1) has current certification from the
2 department as an adjunct instructor; and

3 (2) is not a current teacher or other school
4 employee under the Public School Code;

5 B. "contract for services" means an agreement
6 between the local school board and the adjunct instructor for
7 the provision of services pursuant to the Adjunct Instructors
8 Act;

9 C. "local school board" includes the governing body
10 of a charter school;

11 D. "school district" includes a charter school; and

12 E. "services" includes helping students acquire
13 knowledge in a subject in which an adjunct instructor has
14 professional, technical or career expertise."

15 SECTION 3. A new section of the Public School Code is
16 enacted to read:

17 "[NEW MATERIAL] LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD--ADJUNCT INSTRUCTOR
18 CONTRACT FOR SERVICES.--

19 A. A local school board shall have the authority to
20 enter into a contract for the services with an adjunct
21 instructor.

22 B. The amount of compensation to be received by the
23 adjunct instructor shall be a provision of the contract for
24 services determined by the local school board.

25 C. The adjunct instructor shall provide services

1 not to exceed twenty hours per week.

2 D. The contract for services shall specify that the
3 adjunct instructor is ineligible for:

4 (1) health plan benefits;

5 (2) the accrual of service credit or employee
6 or employer contributions under any coverage plan pursuant to
7 the Public Employees Retirement Act, the Educational Retirement
8 Act or the Deferred Compensation Act;

9 (3) any compensation other than the amount
10 specified in the contract for services; and

11 (4) tenure under any law or regulation or
12 tenure under any agreement to which the adjunct instructor is
13 not an individually named party.

14 E. The term of the contract for services and any
15 renewal of the contract for services shall not exceed one
16 school year.

17 F. A local school board may terminate the contract
18 for services without cause at any time during the contract
19 period.

20 G. A local school board may include in the contract
21 for services additional terms not in contravention of the
22 Adjunct Instructors Act."

23 SECTION 4. A new section of the Public School Code is
24 enacted to read:

25 "[NEW MATERIAL] ADJUNCT INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION.--The

1 department shall certify as an adjunct instructor a person who:

2 A. has earned at least a bachelor's degree;

3 B. has a minimum of three years experience in each
4 area of professional, technical or career expertise in which
5 the adjunct instructor will provide services;

6 C. passes the New Mexico teachers assessments in
7 each area of professional, technical or career expertise in
8 which the adjunct instructor will provide services;

9 D. completes a department-approved pedagogy course
10 provided by the department, a school district or a regional
11 education cooperative; and

12 E. meets any other requirements established by rule
13 by the department."

14 SECTION 5. A new section of the Public School Code is
15 enacted to read:

16 "[NEW MATERIAL] BACKGROUND CHECKS REQUIRED FOR ADJUNCT
17 INSTRUCTORS--SCHOOL PERSONNEL ACT OTHERWISE INAPPLICABLE.--

18 Notwithstanding the applicability of Section 22-10A-5 NMSA
19 1978, all of the other provisions of the School Personnel Act,
20 including licensure requirements, shall not apply to adjunct
21 instructors. Adjunct instructors shall be required to undergo
22 a background check as provided in Section 22-10A-5 NMSA 1978.

23 The school district or charter school may act on the
24 information received from the background check and refuse to
25 approve a person as an adjunct instructor. The school district

2 vetted through the background check process to have
3 unsupervised contact with students."
