

SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL 626

50TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - FIRST SESSION, 2011

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE;
POSTPONING INCREASES IN A CERTAIN DISTRIBUTION FROM THE FIRE
PROTECTION FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 59A-53-5.2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2007,
Chapter 152, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"59A-53-5.2. APPROPRIATIONS AND TRANSFERS FROM THE FIRE
PROTECTION FUND.--

A. For each fiscal year, the amount to be
distributed by the marshal pursuant to Sections 59A-53-4,
59A-53-5 and 59A-53-5.1 NMSA 1978 is appropriated from the fire
protection fund to the commission for the purpose of making the
distributions.

B. For the purposes of Subsections C and D of this

1 section, the "remaining balance in the fire protection fund"
2 shall be calculated on June 30 of each year and shall equal the
3 balance of the fund on that date less the sum of:

4 (1) the total amount to be distributed during
5 the succeeding fiscal year pursuant to Sections 59A-53-4,
6 59A-53-5 and 59A-53-5.1 NMSA 1978; and

7 (2) the total amount of other appropriations
8 from the fire protection fund for the succeeding fiscal year.

9 C. On the following dates, the following
10 percentages of the remaining balance in the fire protection
11 fund shall be transferred from the fire protection fund to the
12 fire protection grant fund:

13 (1) on June 30, 2007, six and seven-tenths
14 percent;

15 (2) on June 30, 2008, thirteen and four-tenths
16 percent;

17 (3) on June 30, 2009, thirteen and four-tenths
18 percent;

19 (4) on June 30, 2010, thirteen and four-tenths
20 percent;

21 (5) on June 30, 2011, thirteen and four-tenths
22 percent;

23 (6) on June 30, 2012, thirteen and four-tenths
24 percent;

25 [~~6~~] (7) on June 30, [~~2012~~] 2013, twenty and

1 one-tenth percent;

2 ~~[(7)]~~ (8) on June 30, ~~[2013]~~ 2014, twenty-six
3 and eight-tenths percent;

5 three and five-tenths percent;

3 on that date pursuant to Subsection C of this section, shall be
4 transferred to the general fund; provided that no transfer
5 shall be made pursuant to this subsection after June 30, [2023]
