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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. A new section of the Inspection of Public
17	Records Act is enacted to read:
18	"[ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] APPOINTIVE EXECUTIVE POSITION
19	EXCEPTIONPUBLICATION REQUIRED OF FINALISTS
20	A. A state agency or institution or political
21	subdivision of the state shall make publicly available on the
22	agency's, institution's or political subdivision's website the
23	names and resumes of no fewer than three finalists for an
24	appointive executive position. The names and resumes shall be
25	made publicly available no fewer than ten days prior to the
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final decision to select one of the finalists for the position. If fewer than three applicants or candidates for an appointive executive position possess the minimum qualifications for the position, those applicants or candidates shall be considered finalists.

B. Records that would reveal the identity of an applicant or candidate for an appointive executive position, except for finalists as provided in this section, are exempt from inspection pursuant to the Inspection of Public Records Act.

C. Letters of reference or medical or psychological data concerning finalists shall not be made public or made available for public inspection or copying.

D. The provisions of this section shall not supersede the provisions of Section 21-1-16.1 NMSA 1978 relating to applicants or nominees for the position of president of a public institution of higher education.

E. For the purposes of this section:

(1) "appointive executive position" means a non-elected chief executive officer of a state agency or institution or political subdivision of the state, but does not include a political appointment, including a cabinet secretary; and
