RELATING TO TAXATION; EXEMPTING A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF SOCIAL SECURITY INCOME FROM INCOME TAX.

AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Income Tax Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] EXEMPTION--SOCIAL SECURITY INCOME.--

- A. An individual may claim an exemption in an amount not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) on the individual's net income from the amount included in adjusted gross income pursuant to Section 86 of the Internal Revenue Code, as that section may be amended or renumbered.
- B. An individual that claims an exemption pursuant to this section shall not claim the exemption pursuant to Section 7-2-5.2 NMSA 1978."

SECTION 2. APPLICABILITY.--The provisions of this act apply to taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2020.
