| 20 | A. A state agency employee shall not disclose                 |
| 21 | sensitive personal information acquired by virtue of the      |

| 23 | physical or mental disability, medical condition, immigration   |

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identification number."

EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the SECTION 2. provisions of this act is July 1, 2021.

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
