2	E. The participants in two plus two shall:	
3	(l) designate an institution to serve as	
4	lead administrator, if needed;	
5	(2) designate a person at each institution	
6	to serve as that institution's lead administrator;	
7	(3) determine what and how data will be	
8	collected, analyzed and evaluated to determine whether the	
9	purpose of two plus two was borne out and whether	
10	articulation changes lead to better outcomes for students and	
11	institutions; and	
12	(4) any other matters necessary for the	
13	conduct and evaluation of two plus two.	
14	F. The participants shall submit interim and final	
15	reports annually to the secretary of higher education and the
