BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 6-24-21 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1995, Chapter 155, Section 21, as amended) is amended to read:

"6-24-21. DRAWINGS FOR AND PAYMENT OF PRIZES--UNCLAIMED PRIZES--APPLICABILITY OF TAXATION.--

All lottery prize drawings shall be open to the 11 Α. If the prior written approval of the chief executive 12 public. officer and the executive vice president for security are 13 obtained, the selection of winning entries may be performed 14 15 by an employee of the lottery. A member of the board shall not perform the selection of a winning entry. Drawings for a 16 prize of more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) shall be 17 conducted and videotaped by the security division and 18 witnessed by the internal auditor of the authority or the 19 20 internal auditor's designee. Promotional drawings for a prize of less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) are exempt 21 from the requirements of this subsection if prior written 22 approval is given by the chief executive officer and the 23 executive vice president for security. All lottery drawing 24 equipment used in public drawings to select winning numbers 25

or entries or participants for prizes shall be examined and tested by the chief executive officer's staff and the internal auditor of the authority or the internal auditor's designee prior to and after each public drawing. 4

B. Any lottery prize is subject to applicable state taxes. The authority shall report to the state and federal taxing authorities any lottery prize exceeding six hundred dollars (\$600).

C. The authority shall adopt rules, policies and 9 procedures to conduct fair and equitable drawings and 10 establish a system of verifying the validity of tickets 11 claimed to win prizes and to effect payment of such prizes, 12 provided: 13

no prize shall be paid upon a ticket (1) 14 purchased or sold in violation of the New Mexico Lottery Act. 15 Any such prize shall constitute an unclaimed prize for 16 purposes of this section; 17

the authority is discharged from all (2) 18 liability upon payment of a prize; 19

the board may by rule provide for the (3) 20 payment of prizes by lottery retailers, whether or not the 21 lottery retailer sold the winning ticket, whenever the amount 22 of the prize is less than an amount set by board rule. 23 Payment shall not be made directly to a player by a machine 24 or a mechanical or electronic device; 25
