16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. [<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] STATE TRANSIT FUND
18	A. The "state transit fund" is created as a
19	nonreverting fund in the state treasury. The fund consists of
20	appropriations, donations, interest from investment of the fund
21	and other money distributed to the fund. The fund shall be
22	administered by the department, and money in the fund is
23	appropriated to the department to provide funds to public
24	transit agencies as provided by this section. Disbursements
25	from the fund shall be made by warrant of the secretary of

3 A public transit agency that submits a funding Β. request to the department to match federal grant funds for 4 5 general public transit operations and public transit 6 infrastructure of a public transit agency shall be eligible to 7 receive money from the state transit fund; provided that, for 8 the purpose of providing matching funds, money from the fund 9 may only be used to provide up to fifty percent of the matching 10 funds required to be provided by the public transit agency for 11 public transit operations and for public transit 12 infrastructure. Money in the fund shall not be used for 13 expenses associated with commuter rail services.

15 (1) "department" means the department of 16 transportation;

(2) "public transit agency" means a tribal entity or a municipality, county, regional transit district created pursuant to the Regional Transit District Act or other instrumentality of the state or of a municipality or county that provides public transportation services; and

(3) "public transit infrastructure" means vehicles, including buses and vans, bus stops, passenger stations, telecommunications systems and other infrastructure and real property necessary to provide public transportation .221837.2
