23	congested by an excess of unnecessary and obsolete rules and
24	mandates and cause hardships on New Mexico's local governments,

WHEREAS, constitutionally applied mechanisms for establishing sound requirements for accountability of federal spending, regulation and public service are necessary to the well-being of the people;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the legislature of New Mexico hereby applies to congress, under the provisions of Article 5 of the United States constitution, for the calling of a convention of the states limited to proposing amendment to the United States constitution for consideration by all fifty states to impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, to limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government and to limit the terms for its officials and for members of congress; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be delivered, within thirty days of its passage, to the president of the United States senate, the secretary of the United States senate, the speaker of the United States house of representatives, the clerk of the United States house of representatives and the New Mexico congressional delegation; and
