WHEREAS, Rudolfo Anaya believes that all New Mexico children should be familiar with the folklore and traditions of their state's cultures, such as cuentos, dichos, plays, songs and Native American stories; and

WHEREAS, Rudolfo Anaya has written a children's book about the importance of education and the greatest lesson a child can learn: the value of knowing how to read; and

WHEREAS, the characters and northern New Mexico landscape in the book *Owl in a Straw Hat* come to life and resonate wonderfully with children and adults alike; and

WHEREAS, Rudolfo Anaya's efforts have brought critical attention to reading as the foundation of learning, which is essential to the growth and success of all children and their communities; and

WHEREAS, a reading program was established as a partnership between Rudolfo Anaya and the Christopher Montalvo memorial fund to inspire children to read more, and it is now .210071.1

in its third year; and

WHEREAS, the goal of this reading program is to encourage and recognize reading achievements by New Mexico children at home and in every New Mexico school;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 14, 2018 be declared "Rudolfo Anaya I Love To Read Day" in the senate; and
