WHEREAS, Molina healthcare of New Mexico is ranked the number one medicaid health plan in New Mexico;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 11, 2015 be declared "Molina Day" in the senate; and
