SUMMARY—Increases the maximum amount of certain fees imposed by the Speech-Language Pathology, Audiology and Hearing Aid Dispensing Board. (BDR 54-603)

AN ACT relating to professions; increasing the maximum amount of certain fees imposed by the Speech-Language Pathology, Audiology and Hearing Aid Dispensing Board; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Existing law establishes the maximum fees the Speech-Language Pathology,
2 Audiology and Hearing Aid Dispensing Board may charge for certain tasks relating
3 to the licensing of audiologists, speech-language pathologists and persons engaged
4 in the practice of fitting and dispensing hearing aids. (NRS 637B.175) This bill
5 increases the maximum fee the Board may impose for the application fee, license
6 fee, fee for the renewal of a license, reinstatement fee and fee for obtaining license
7 information.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 637B.175 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:
3 637B.175 1. The Board shall charge and collect only the
4 following fees whose amounts must be determined by the Board, but
5 may not exceed:



1	Application fee	[\$150] \$200
2	License fee.....	[\$100] 150
3	Fee for the renewal of a license	[\$100] 150
4	Reinstatement fee	[\$100] 200
5	Examination fee.....	300
6	Fee for converting to a different type of license.....	50
7	Fee for each additional license or endorsement.....	50
8	Fee for obtaining license information.....	[\$50] 100

10 2. If an applicant submits an application for a license by
11 endorsement pursuant to NRS 637B.204, the Board shall collect not
12 more than one-half of the fee set forth in subsection 1 for the initial
13 issuance of the license.

14 3. All fees are payable in advance and may not be refunded.

15 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2021.
