#### ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 186-ASSEMBLYWOMAN KASAMA

SUMMARY—Establishes requirements relating to the provision of drinking water at food establishments. (BDR 40-454)

EXPLANATION - Matter in bolded italics is new; matter between brackets formitted material is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to food establishments; prohibiting a food establishment from providing drinking water unless requested by a customer; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

#### **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Existing law sets forth various provisions governing the regulation of food establishments. (Chapter 446 of NRS) Existing law further requires a health authority to inspect each food establishment in this State at least once each year. (NRS 446.885) **Section 1** of this bill prohibits a food establishment from providing drinking water to a customer unless the customer requests drinking water. **Section 1** also: (1) requires a food establishment to demonstrate compliance with this prohibition upon inspection by the health authority; and (2) authorizes the State Board of Health and local boards of health to adopt regulations setting forth how a food establishment may show compliance with this prohibition.

Sections 1 and 2 of this bill provide that a food establishment is not subject to any penalty or fine for a violation of section 1.

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Chapter 446 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. A food establishment may not provide drinking water to a customer unless the customer requests drinking water.
- 2. During an inspection conducted by the health authority pursuant to NRS 446.885, a food establishment shall demonstrate

to the satisfaction of the health authority that the food establishment complies with the provisions of subsection 1. The regulations adopted by the State Board of Health or a local board of health pursuant to NRS 446.940 may set forth requirements for a food establishment to demonstrate such compliance.

3. A food establishment is not subject to any penalty or fine for a violation of this section.

**Sec. 2.** NRS 446.945 is hereby amended to read as follows:

446.945 Except as otherwise provided in NRS 446.872 [,] and section 1 of this act, any person who violates any of the provisions of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor. In addition thereto, such persons may be enjoined from continuing such violations. Each day upon which such a violation occurs shall constitute a separate violation.
