THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 228 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *If directed by the Governor or if, in the opinion of the Attorney
4 General, the rights of residents of this State under the Second
5 Amendment to the United States Constitution have been infringed
6 by an executive order issued by the President of the United States
7 and it is necessary that a suit be commenced in any federal or state
8 court to protect and secure such rights, the Attorney General shall
9 commence the action.*

10 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
