AN ACT relating to property; providing that the authority of certain courts to grant a stay in certain proceedings concerning evictions expires on May 31, 2021; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law sets forth certain actions and proceedings concerning the eviction of a tenant of any dwelling unit, apartment, mobile home, recreational vehicle or part of a low-rent housing program operated by a public housing authority. (Chapter 40 of NRS) Existing law authorizes a court to stay such eviction proceedings for a period of not more than 30 days to facilitate an expedited program of alternative dispute resolution established by the Nevada Supreme Court or a district court or justice court. (NRS 40.2544) **Section 1** of this bill removes the authority of a court to stay such eviction proceedings, effective on May 31, 2021. **Section 2** of this bill provides that the provisions of this bill do not apply to any such eviction proceeding stayed by a court before May 31, 2021.
