**AN ACT** relating to the Nevada Silver Haired Legislative Forum; revising the residency requirements to be eligible for appointment as a member of the Forum; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 Existing law establishes the Nevada Silver Haired Legislative Forum and  
2 authorizes the Forum to make recommendations for legislative action concerning  
3 issues relating to senior citizens. (NRS 427A.320, 427A.390) To be eligible for  
4 appointment as a member of the Forum, a person must: (1) have been a resident of  
5 this State for 5 years immediately preceding his or her appointment; (2) have been a  
6 registered voter in the senatorial district of the Senator who nominated the member  
7 for 3 years immediately preceding his or her appointment; and (3) be at least 60  
8 years of age on the day that he or she is appointed. (NRS 427A.340) This bill  
9 decreases the time a person is required to have been a registered voter in the  
10 senatorial district of the Senator who nominated the member from 3 years to 1 year  
11 immediately preceding his or her appointment for the person to be eligible for  
12 appointment as a member of the Forum.



THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     **Section 1.** NRS 427A.340 is hereby amended to read as  
2 follows:

3     427A.340 To be eligible for appointment as a member of the  
4 Forum pursuant to NRS 427A.330, a person must:

5     1. Have been a resident of this state for 5 years immediately  
6 preceding his or her appointment;

7     2. Have been a registered voter in the senatorial district of the  
8 Senator who nominated the member for ~~{3—years}~~ *1 year*  
9 immediately preceding his or her appointment; and

10    3. Be at least 60 years of age on the day that he or she is  
11 appointed.

12    **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
