AN ACT relating to law enforcement; authorizing a state or local law enforcement agency to enter into an agreement relating to the enforcement of federal immigration laws by officers of the state or local law enforcement agency; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing federal law provides that a state or local law enforcement agency may
2 enter into an agreement with the Attorney General of the United States which vests
3 officers of the state or local law enforcement agency with certain powers relating to
4 the enforcement of federal immigration laws. (8 U.S.C. § 1357(g)) This bill
5 expressly authorizes a state or local law enforcement agency to enter into such
6 agreements.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 178 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *A state or local law enforcement agency may enter into an*
4 *agreement with the Attorney General of the United States relating*
5 *to the enforcement of federal immigration laws by officers of the*
6 *state or local law enforcement agency pursuant to section 287(g)*
7 *of the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1357(g).*



1 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2021.
