
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 24—COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION

(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES)

PREFILED DECEMBER 19, 2012

Referred to Committee on Transportation

SUMMARY—Makes various changes to provisions relating to license plates. (BDR 43-367)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: No.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets ~~omitted material~~ is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; providing for the limited issuance of special license plates to commemorate the 150th anniversary of Nevada’s admission into the Union; imposing a fee for the issuance or renewal of such license plates; revising provisions relating to the number of characters required to be contained on a license plate; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 This bill provides for the issuance of a special license plate to commemorate
2 the 150th anniversary of Nevada’s admission into the Union. Existing law provides
3 that the regular fees for the initial issuance and renewal of a special license plate are
4 \$35 and \$10, respectively, exclusive of any additional fees which may be added to
5 generate funds for a particular cause. (NRS 482.265) Unlike the fees set forth in
6 existing law, the fee set forth in this bill for the initial issuance of a special license
7 plate to commemorate the 150th anniversary (sesquicentennial) of Nevada’s
8 admission into the Union is \$7.50 and there is no basic charge for the renewal of
9 the special license plates, other than the fee that is required to be distributed to the
10 Nevada Cultural Affairs Foundation. Existing law also requires \$35 of the fee
11 received by the Department of Motor Vehicles for the initial issuance of a special
12 license plate, exclusive of any additional fees which may be added to generate
13 funds for a particular cause, to be deposited in the State Highway Fund for credit to
14 the Revolving Account for the Issuance of Special License Plates. (NRS 482.1805)
15 However, this bill requires the Department to deposit the \$7.50 received for the
16 initial issuance of the sesquicentennial license plate with the State Treasurer for
17 credit to the Motor Vehicle Fund.

18 This bill also provides that the additional fees collected for the issuance of the
19 plate must be deposited in the State General Fund. The State Treasurer is required



20 to distribute those additional fees, on a quarterly basis, to the Nevada Cultural
21 Affairs Foundation. This bill exempts these special license plates from: (1) the
22 provisions that require a minimum number of applications for the plates; (2) the
23 requirement that the Commission on Special License Plates approve or disapprove
24 the plates; and (3) the limit on the number of separate designs of special license
25 plates that may be issued by the Department at any one time.

26 **Section 5** of this bill deletes the requirement that a redesign of license plates
27 ordered by the Director of the Department: (1) be in colors that are predominately
28 blue and silver; and (2) contain letters and numbers that are of the same size.
29 **Sections 6 and 11-19** of this bill delete the requirement that a license plate contain
30 a certain finite number of characters and provide instead that the Director will
31 determine the number of characters to be contained on each license plate.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 482 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 7, the*
4 *Department, in cooperation with the Nevada Cultural Affairs*
5 *Foundation or its successor, shall design, prepare and issue*
6 *license plates which commemorate the 150th anniversary of*
7 *Nevada's admission into the Union, using any colors and designs*
8 *that the Department deems appropriate.*

9 *2. The Department shall issue the commemorative license*
10 *plates for a passenger car or light commercial vehicle upon*
11 *application by a person who is entitled to license plates pursuant*
12 *to NRS 482.265 and who otherwise complies with the*
13 *requirements for registration and licensing pursuant to this*
14 *chapter. A person may request that personalized prestige license*
15 *plates issued pursuant to NRS 482.3667 be combined with the*
16 *commemorative license plates if that person pays the fees for*
17 *the personalized license plates in addition to the fees for the*
18 *commemorative license plates pursuant to subsections 3 and 4.*

19 *3. The fee for the commemorative license plates is \$7.50, in*
20 *addition to all other applicable registration and license fees and*
21 *governmental services taxes. The Department shall deposit the fee*
22 *collected pursuant to this subsection with the State Treasurer for*
23 *credit to the Motor Vehicle Fund pursuant to the provisions of*
24 *NRS 482.180.*

25 *4. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, in addition*
26 *to all other applicable registration and license fees and*
27 *governmental services taxes and the fees prescribed in subsection*
28 *3, a person who requests a set of the commemorative license plates*
29 *must pay for the initial issuance of the plates an additional fee of*
30 *\$25 and for each renewal of the plates a fee of \$10, to be*



1 *distributed pursuant to subsection 5. The fees otherwise required*
2 *to be paid pursuant to this subsection must not be charged after*
3 *the date announced by the Director pursuant to subsection 7.*

4 *5. The Department shall deposit the fees collected pursuant to*
5 *subsection 4 with the State Treasurer for credit to the State*
6 *General Fund. For the duration of the collection of such fees, the*
7 *State Treasurer shall, on a quarterly basis, distribute the fees to*
8 *the Nevada Cultural Affairs Foundation or its successor to be*
9 *used for:*

10 *(a) A celebration of the 150th anniversary of Nevada's*
11 *admission into the Union;*

12 *(b) Projects relating to the commemoration of Nevada's*
13 *admission to the Union, including, without limitation, historical*
14 *markers, tours of historic sites and improvements to or restoration*
15 *of historic buildings and structures;*

16 *(c) Education relating to the history of the State of Nevada;*
17 *and*

18 *(d) Other projects relating to preserving and protecting the*
19 *heritage of the State of Nevada.*

20 *6. If, during a registration year, the holder of the*
21 *commemorative license plates issued pursuant to the provisions of*
22 *this section disposes of the vehicle to which the plates are affixed,*
23 *the holder shall:*

24 *(a) Retain the commemorative license plates and affix them to*
25 *another vehicle that meets the requirements of this section if the*
26 *holder pays the fee for the transfer of the registration and any*
27 *registration fee or governmental services tax due pursuant to*
28 *NRS 482.399; or*

29 *(b) Within 30 days after removing the commemorative license*
30 *plates from the vehicle, return them to the Department.*

31 *7. The Director shall determine and, by public proclamation,*
32 *announce the last date on which the Department will issue the*
33 *commemorative license plates. The Department shall publish the*
34 *announcement on its Internet website. The Department shall not*
35 *issue:*

36 *(a) The commemorative license plates after the date*
37 *announced by the Director pursuant to this subsection.*

38 *(b) Replacement commemorative license plates for those*
39 *license plates more than 5 years after the date announced by the*
40 *Director pursuant to this subsection.*

41 **Sec. 2.** NRS 482.1805 is hereby amended to read as follows:

42 482.1805 1. The Revolving Account for the Issuance of
43 Special License Plates is hereby created as a special account in the
44 State Highway Fund. An amount equal to \$35 of the fee received by
45 the Department for the initial issuance of a special license plate, not



1 including any additional fee which may be added to generate
2 financial support for a particular cause or charitable organization,
3 must be deposited in the State Highway Fund for credit to the
4 Account.

5 2. The Department shall use the money in the Account to:

6 (a) Pay the expenses involved in issuing special license plates;
7 and

8 (b) Purchase improved and upgraded technology, including,
9 without limitation, digital technology for the production of special
10 license plates, to ensure that special license plates are produced in
11 the most efficient manner possible.

12 3. Money in the Account must be used only for the purposes
13 specified in subsection 2.

14 4. At the end of each fiscal year, the State Controller shall
15 transfer from the Account to the State Highway Fund an amount of
16 money equal to the balance in the Account which exceeds \$50,000.

17 **5. *The provisions of this section do not apply to section 1 of***
18 ***this act.***

19 **Sec. 3.** NRS 482.216 is hereby amended to read as follows:

20 482.216 1. Upon the request of a new vehicle dealer, the
21 Department may authorize the new vehicle dealer to:

22 (a) Accept applications for the registration of the new motor
23 vehicles he or she sells and the related fees and taxes;

24 (b) Issue certificates of registration to applicants who satisfy the
25 requirements of this chapter; and

26 (c) Accept applications for the transfer of registration pursuant
27 to NRS 482.399 if the applicant purchased from the new vehicle
28 dealer a new vehicle to which the registration is to be transferred.

29 2. A new vehicle dealer who is authorized to issue certificates
30 of registration pursuant to subsection 1 shall:

31 (a) Transmit the applications received to the Department within
32 the period prescribed by the Department;

33 (b) Transmit the fees collected from the applicants and properly
34 account for them within the period prescribed by the Department;

35 (c) Comply with the regulations adopted pursuant to subsection
36 4; and

37 (d) Bear any cost of equipment which is necessary to issue
38 certificates of registration, including any computer hardware or
39 software.

40 3. A new vehicle dealer who is authorized to issue certificates
41 of registration pursuant to subsection 1 shall not:

42 (a) Charge any additional fee for the performance of those
43 services;

44 (b) Receive compensation from the Department for the
45 performance of those services;



1 (c) Accept applications for the renewal of registration of a motor
2 vehicle; or

3 (d) Accept an application for the registration of a motor vehicle
4 if the applicant wishes to:

5 (1) Obtain special license plates pursuant to NRS 482.3667
6 to 482.3823, inclusive ~~H~~, *and section 1 of this act*; or

7 (2) Claim the exemption from the governmental services tax
8 provided pursuant to NRS 361.1565 to veterans and their relations.

9 4. The Director shall adopt such regulations as are necessary to
10 carry out the provisions of this section. The regulations adopted
11 pursuant to this subsection must provide for:

12 (a) The expedient and secure issuance of license plates and
13 decals by the Department; and

14 (b) The withdrawal of the authority granted to a new vehicle
15 dealer pursuant to subsection 1 if that dealer fails to comply with the
16 regulations adopted by the Department.

17 **Sec. 4.** NRS 482.265 is hereby amended to read as follows:

18 482.265 1. The Department shall furnish to every owner
19 whose vehicle is registered two license plates for a motor vehicle
20 other than a motorcycle and one license plate for all other vehicles
21 required to be registered hereunder. Upon renewal of registration,
22 the Department may issue one or more license plate stickers, tabs or
23 other suitable devices in lieu of new license plates.

24 2. The Director shall have the authority to require the return to
25 the Department of all number plates upon termination of the lawful
26 use thereof by the owner under this chapter.

27 3. Except as otherwise specifically provided by statute, for the
28 issuance of each special license plate authorized pursuant to this
29 chapter:

30 (a) The fee to be received by the Department for the initial
31 issuance of the special license plate is \$35, exclusive of any
32 additional fee which may be added to generate funds for a particular
33 cause or charitable organization;

34 (b) The fee to be received by the Department for the renewal of
35 the special license plate is \$10, exclusive of any additional fee
36 which may be added to generate financial support for a particular
37 cause or charitable organization; and

38 (c) The Department shall not design, prepare or issue a special
39 license plate unless, within 4 years after the date on which the
40 measure authorizing the issuance becomes effective, it receives at
41 least 250 applications for the issuance of that plate.

42 *4. The provisions of subsection 3 do not apply to section 1 of*
43 *this act.*



1 **Sec. 5.** NRS 482.270 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 482.270 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section or by
3 specific statute, the Director shall order the redesign and preparation
4 of motor vehicle license plates . ~~[with colors that are predominately~~
5 ~~blue and silver. The Director may substitute white in place of silver~~
6 ~~when no suitable material is available.]~~

7 2. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, the
8 Department shall, upon the payment of all applicable fees, issue
9 redesigned motor vehicle license plates pursuant to this section to
10 persons who apply for the registration or renewal of the registration
11 of a motor vehicle on or after January 1, 2001.

12 3. The Department shall not issue redesigned motor vehicle
13 license plates pursuant to this section to a person who was issued
14 motor vehicle license plates before January 1, 1982, or pursuant to
15 NRS 482.3747, 482.3763, 482.3775, 482.378 or 482.379, *or section*
16 *1 of this act*, without the approval of the person.

17 4. The Director may determine and vary the size, shape and
18 form and the material of which license plates are made, but each
19 license plate must be of sufficient size to be plainly readable from a
20 distance of 100 feet during daylight. All license plates must be
21 treated to reflect light and to be at least 100 times brighter than
22 conventional painted number plates. When properly mounted on an
23 unlighted vehicle, the license plates, when viewed from a vehicle
24 equipped with standard headlights, must be visible for a distance of
25 not less than 1,500 feet and readable for a distance of not less than
26 110 feet.

27 5. Every license plate must have displayed upon it:

28 (a) The registration number, or combination of letters and
29 numbers, assigned to the vehicle and to the owner thereof;

30 (b) The name of this State, which may be abbreviated;

31 (c) If issued for a calendar year, the year; and

32 (d) If issued for a registration period other than a calendar year,
33 the month and year the registration expires.

34 6. ~~[Except as otherwise provided in NRS 482.379, all letters~~
35 ~~and numbers must be of the same size.~~

36 ~~7.]~~ Each special license plate that is designed, prepared and
37 issued pursuant to NRS 482.367002 must be designed and prepared
38 in such a manner that:

39 (a) The left-hand one-third of the plate is the only part of the
40 plate on which is displayed any design or other insignia that is
41 suggested pursuant to paragraph (e) of subsection 2 of that section;
42 and

43 (b) The remainder of the plate conforms to the requirements for
44 ~~[coloring.]~~ lettering and design that are set forth in this section.



1 **Sec. 6.** NRS 482.272 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 482.272 Each license plate for a motorcycle may contain ~~up to~~
3 ~~six~~ *a number of* characters, including numbers and letters ~~H~~, *as*
4 *determined necessary by the Director.* Only one plate may be
5 issued for a motorcycle.

6 **Sec. 7.** NRS 482.367002 is hereby amended to read as
7 follows:

8 482.367002 1. A person may request that the Department
9 design, prepare and issue a special license plate by submitting an
10 application to the Department. A person may submit an application
11 for a special license plate that is intended to generate financial
12 support for an organization only if:

13 (a) For an organization which is not a governmental entity, the
14 organization is established as a nonprofit charitable organization
15 which provides services to the community relating to public health,
16 education or general welfare;

17 (b) For an organization which is a governmental entity, the
18 organization only uses the financial support generated by the special
19 license plate for charitable purposes relating to public health,
20 education or general welfare;

21 (c) The organization is registered with the Secretary of State, if
22 registration is required by law, and has filed any documents required
23 to remain registered with the Secretary of State;

24 (d) The name and purpose of the organization do not promote,
25 advertise or endorse any specific product, brand name or service that
26 is offered for profit;

27 (e) The organization is nondiscriminatory; and

28 (f) The license plate will not promote a specific religion, faith or
29 antireligious belief.

30 2. An application submitted to the Department pursuant to
31 subsection 1:

32 (a) Must be on a form prescribed and furnished by the
33 Department;

34 (b) Must specify whether the special license plate being
35 requested is intended to generate financial support for a particular
36 cause or charitable organization and, if so, the name of the cause or
37 charitable organization;

38 (c) Must include proof that the organization satisfies the
39 requirements set forth in subsection 1;

40 (d) Must be accompanied by a surety bond posted with the
41 Department in the amount of \$5,000; and

42 (e) May be accompanied by suggestions for the design of and
43 colors to be used in the special license plate.

44 3. The Department may design and prepare a special license
45 plate requested pursuant to subsection 1 if:



1 (a) The Department determines that the application for that plate
2 complies with subsection 2; and

3 (b) The Commission on Special License Plates approves the
4 application for that plate pursuant to subsection 5 of
5 NRS 482.367004.

6 4. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 482.367008, the
7 Department may issue a special license plate that:

8 (a) The Department has designed and prepared pursuant to this
9 section;

10 (b) The Commission on Special License Plates has approved for
11 issuance pursuant to subsection 5 of NRS 482.367004; and

12 (c) Complies with the requirements of subsection ~~7~~ 6 of
13 NRS 482.270,

14 ↪ for any passenger car or light commercial vehicle upon
15 application by a person who is entitled to license plates pursuant to
16 NRS 482.265 and who otherwise complies with the requirements for
17 registration and licensing pursuant to this chapter. A person may
18 request that personalized prestige license plates issued pursuant to
19 NRS 482.3667 be combined with a special license plate issued
20 pursuant to this section if that person pays the fees for personalized
21 prestige license plates in addition to the fees for the special license
22 plate.

23 5. The Department must promptly release the surety bond
24 posted pursuant to subsection 2:

25 (a) If the Department or the Commission on Special License
26 Plates determines not to issue the special license plate; or

27 (b) If it is determined that at least 1,000 special license plates
28 have been issued pursuant to the assessment of the viability of the
29 design of the special license plate conducted pursuant to
30 NRS 482.367008.

31 6. If, during a registration year, the holder of license plates
32 issued pursuant to the provisions of this section disposes of the
33 vehicle to which the plates are affixed, the holder shall:

34 (a) Retain the plates and affix them to another vehicle that meets
35 the requirements of this section if the holder pays the fee for the
36 transfer of the registration and any registration fee or governmental
37 services tax due pursuant to NRS 482.399; or

38 (b) Within 30 days after removing the plates from the vehicle,
39 return them to the Department.

40 **Sec. 8.** NRS 482.367004 is hereby amended to read as
41 follows:

42 482.367004 1. There is hereby created the Commission on
43 Special License Plates consisting of five Legislators and three
44 nonvoting members as follows:

45 (a) Five Legislators appointed by the Legislative Commission:



1 (1) One of whom is the Legislator who served as the Chair of
2 the Assembly Standing Committee on Transportation during the
3 most recent legislative session. That Legislator may designate an
4 alternate to serve in place of the Legislator when absent. The
5 alternate must be another Legislator who also served on the
6 Assembly Standing Committee on Transportation during the most
7 recent legislative session.

8 (2) One of whom is the Legislator who served as the Chair of
9 the Senate Standing Committee on Transportation during the most
10 recent legislative session. That Legislator may designate an alternate
11 to serve in place of the Legislator when absent. The alternate must
12 be another Legislator who also served on the Senate Standing
13 Committee on Transportation during the most recent legislative
14 session.

15 (b) Three nonvoting members consisting of:

16 (1) The Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles, or a
17 designee of the Director.

18 (2) The Director of the Department of Public Safety, or a
19 designee of the Director.

20 (3) The Director of the Department of Tourism and Cultural
21 Affairs, or a designee of the Director.

22 2. Each member of the Commission appointed pursuant to
23 paragraph (a) of subsection 1 serves a term of 2 years, commencing
24 on July 1 of each odd-numbered year. A vacancy on the
25 Commission must be filled in the same manner as the original
26 appointment.

27 3. Members of the Commission serve without salary or
28 compensation for their travel or per diem expenses.

29 4. The Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau shall
30 provide administrative support to the Commission.

31 5. The Commission shall approve or disapprove:

32 (a) Applications for the design, preparation and issuance of
33 special license plates that are submitted to the Department pursuant
34 to subsection 1 of NRS 482.367002;

35 (b) The issuance by the Department of special license plates that
36 have been designed and prepared pursuant to NRS 482.367002; and

37 (c) Except as otherwise provided in subsection 6, applications
38 for the design, preparation and issuance of special license plates that
39 have been authorized by an act of the Legislature after January 1,
40 2007.

41 ➤ In determining whether to approve such an application or
42 issuance, the Commission shall consider, without limitation,
43 whether it would be appropriate and feasible for the Department to,
44 as applicable, design, prepare or issue the particular special license
45 plate. The Commission shall consider each application in the



1 chronological order in which the application was received by the
2 Department.

3 6. The provisions of paragraph (c) of subsection 5 do not apply
4 with regard to special license plates that are issued pursuant to NRS
5 482.3785 or 482.3787 ~~H~~ *or section 1 of this act.*

6 7. The Commission shall:

7 (a) Approve or disapprove any proposed change in the
8 distribution of money received in the form of additional fees. As
9 used in this paragraph, "additional fees" means the fees that are
10 charged in connection with the issuance or renewal of a special
11 license plate for the benefit of a particular cause, fund or charitable
12 organization. The term does not include registration and license fees
13 or governmental services taxes.

14 (b) If it approves a proposed change pursuant to paragraph (a)
15 and determines that legislation is required to carry out the change,
16 request the assistance of the Legislative Counsel in the preparation
17 of a bill draft to carry out the change.

18 **Sec. 9.** NRS 482.367008 is hereby amended to read as
19 follows:

20 482.367008 1. As used in this section, "special license plate"
21 means:

22 (a) A license plate that the Department has designed and
23 prepared pursuant to NRS 482.367002 in accordance with the
24 system of application and petition described in that section;

25 (b) A license plate approved by the Legislature that the
26 Department has designed and prepared pursuant to NRS 482.3747,
27 482.37903, 482.37905, 482.37917, 482.379175, 482.37918,
28 482.37919, 482.3792, 482.3793, 482.37933, 482.37934, 482.37935,
29 482.379355, 482.379365, 482.37937, 482.379375, 482.37938 or
30 482.37945; and

31 (c) Except for a license plate that is issued pursuant to NRS
32 482.3785 or 482.3787, *or section 1 of this act*, a license plate that ~~f~~

33 ~~—(1) Is~~ *is* approved by the Legislature after July 1, 2005. ~~f~~ *and*

34 ~~—(2) Differs substantially in design from the license plates that~~
35 ~~are described in subsection 1 of NRS 482.270.~~

36 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
37 the Department shall not, at any one time, issue more than 30
38 separate designs of special license plates. Whenever the total
39 number of separate designs of special license plates issued by the
40 Department at any one time is less than 30, the Department shall
41 issue a number of additional designs of special license plates that
42 have been authorized by an act of the Legislature or the application
43 for which has been approved by the Commission on Special License
44 Plates pursuant to subsection 5 of NRS 482.367004, not to exceed a
45 total of 30 designs issued by the Department at any one time. Such



1 additional designs must be issued by the Department in accordance
2 with the chronological order of their authorization or approval.

3 3. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, on
4 October 1 of each year the Department shall assess the viability of
5 each separate design of special license plate that the Department is
6 currently issuing by determining the total number of validly
7 registered motor vehicles to which that design of special license
8 plate is affixed. The Department shall not determine the total
9 number of validly registered motor vehicles to which a particular
10 design of special license plate is affixed if:

11 (a) The particular design of special license plate was designed
12 and prepared by the Department pursuant to NRS 482.367002; and

13 (b) On October 1, that particular design of special license plate
14 has been available to be issued for less than 12 months.

20 the Department pursuant to NRS 482.367002, less than 1,000; or

21 (b) In the case of special license plates authorized directly by the

23 less than the number of applications required to be received by the
24 Department for the initial issuance of those plates,

25 \rightarrow the Director shall provide notice of that fact in the manner

27 5. The notice required pursuant to subsection 4 must be
28 provided:

29 (a) If the special license plate generates financial support for a
30 cause or charitable organization, to that cause or charitable

33 support for a cause or charitable organization, to an entity which is
34 involved in promoting the activity, place or other matter that is
35 depicted on the plate.

36 6. If, on December 31 of the same year in which notice was
37 provided pursuant to subsections 4 and 5, the total number of validly
38 registered motor vehicles to which a particular design of special
39 license plate is affixed is:

40 (a) In the case of special license plates designed and prepared by
41 the Department pursuant to NRS 482.367002, less than 1,000; or

42 (b) In the case of special license plates authorized directly by the
43 Legislature which are described in paragraph (b) of subsection 1,
44 less than the number of applications required to be received by the
Department for the initial issuance of those plates,



1 ↳ the Director shall, notwithstanding any other provision of law to
2 the contrary, issue an order providing that the Department will no
3 longer issue that particular design of special license plate. Such an
4 order does not require existing holders of that particular design of
5 special license plate to surrender their plates to the Department and
6 does not prohibit those holders from renewing those plates.

7 **Sec. 10.** NRS 482.36705 is hereby amended to read as
8 follows:
