AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; revising the penalty for the unlawful possession of unregistered vehicles unfit for use; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 With certain exceptions, existing law makes it a misdemeanor for a person to
2 keep more than two unregistered vehicles on real property owned by or under the
3 possession or control of the person if the vehicles are no longer intended for or in
4 condition for lawful use on the highway. (NRS 487.290, 487.300) This bill revises
5 the penalty by providing that such an act is punishable by a civil penalty of not
6 more than \$100 for each day of the violation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 487.300 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 487.300 **1.** Every person who violates any provision of NRS
3 487.281 ~~for 487.290~~ is guilty of a misdemeanor.
4 **2.** *Any person who violates any provision of NRS 487.290 is*
5 *liable for a civil penalty of not more than \$100 for each day of the*
6 *violation.*
