## ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 334–ASSEMBLYMAN WHEELER

SUMMARY—Authorizes an association of elected sheriffs and other chief executive officers of city, county or state law enforcement agencies to request the drafting of a certain number of legislative measures for each regular session. (BDR 17-172)

AN ACT relating to the Legislature; authorizing an association of elected sheriffs and other chief executive officers of city, county or state law enforcement agencies to request the drafting of a certain number of legislative measures for each regular session; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law specifies the number of legislative measures various persons and entities may request the Legislative Counsel to draft for each regular session of the Nevada Legislature. (NRS 218D.150-218D.220, 385.565) This bill authorizes an association of elected sheriffs and other chief executive officers of city, county or state law enforcement agencies to request the drafting of not more than three legislative measures for each regular session of the Nevada Legislature.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 218D.210 is hereby amended to read as 2 follows:

218D.210 1. For a regular session, an association of counties
or cities may request the drafting of not more than 5 legislative
measures. The requests must be submitted to the Legislative
Counsel on or before September 1 preceding the regular session.





1 2. For a regular session, an association of elected sheriffs 2 and other chief executive officers of city, county or state law 3 enforcement agencies may request the drafting of not more than 3 4 legislative measures. The requests must be submitted to the 5 Legislative Counsel on or before September 1 preceding the 6 regular session.

**3.** Each request made pursuant to this section must be on a form prescribed by the Legislative Counsel. The legislative measures requested pursuant to this section must be prefiled on or before December 20 preceding the regular session. A legislative measure that is not prefiled on or before that date shall be deemed withdrawn.

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
