

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 336—ASSEMBLYWOMAN KIRKPATRICK

MARCH 18, 2013

Referred to Committee on Transportation

SUMMARY—Provides for an extended term of vehicle registration for certain trailers. (BDR 43-240)

AN ACT relating to vehicle registration; authorizing the registration of certain trailers for a 3-year period in lieu of a 12-month period; requiring a registrant who elects to register a trailer for the longer period to pay fees commensurate with that longer period; authorizing the registration of certain commercial trailers and semitrailers for as long as the trailer is owned by the person who obtained the registration; providing for a one-time imposition of a flat governmental services tax on commercial trailers registered for as long as the trailer is owned by the person who obtained the registration; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law requires the annual registration of trailers and semitrailers that are
2 to be operated on the highways of this State and the imposition of a governmental
3 services tax. (NRS 371.030, 482.205, 482.206) **Section 1.4** of this bill allows a
4 person who owns a trailer to instead elect to register the trailer for a period of 3
5 years. **Section 1.4** also requires a person who registers a trailer for a 3-year period
6 to pay upon registration all applicable fees and taxes which the person would pay if
7 the trailer was registered for 1 year and then renewed for 2 consecutive years,
8 including, without limitation, governmental services taxes, registration fees, license
9 plate fees and additional fees, if applicable, for personalized prestige license plates
10 and special license plates.
11 **Sections 2, 3, 34.5 and 36** of this bill authorize the owners of certain
12 commercial trailers and semitrailers to pay a flat registration fee of \$24 and the
13 imposition of the governmental services tax in the amount of \$86 for a registration
14 that is valid for as long as the person owns the trailer. **Section 2** provides that such
15 a registration is nontransferable if the person transfers ownership of the trailer, and
16 is valid until the owner either transfers ownership of the trailer or cancels the

17 registration of the trailer and surrenders the license plates to the Department of
18 Motor Vehicles. **Section 36** provides that the governmental services tax is imposed
19 only when the trailer is registered and is nonrefundable. **Section 4.5** of this bill
20 provides that the Department shall not, for a trailer being registered in this manner,
21 issue any of the various special license plates offered for other vehicles.

22 **Sections 2-4, 5 and 35** of this bill make conforming changes to provisions
23 concerning the transfer of registration, the imposition of the governmental services
24 tax, renewal stickers, the replacement of license plates or decals that are lost,
25 mutilated or illegible, and the reporting of stolen motor vehicles, trailers or
26 semitrailers. (NRS 482.206, 482.260, 482.2705, 482.285, 482.520) **Sections 6-34.1**
27 of this bill make conforming changes to provisions authorizing the issuance of
28 special license plates which are available for certain trailers and semitrailers.
29 **Sections 36-38** of this bill make conforming changes to provisions concerning the
30 imposition of the governmental services tax.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 482 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto the provisions set forth as sections 1.2 and 1.4 of this act.

3 **Sec. 1.2.** *“Full trailer” means any commercial vehicle*
4 *without motive power supported by front and rear axles and pulled*
5 *by a drawbar.*

6 **Sec. 1.4. 1.** *A trailer may be registered for a 3-year period*
7 *as provided in this section.*

8 **2.** *A person who registers a trailer for a 3-year period must*
9 *pay upon registration all fees and taxes that would be due during*
10 *the 3-year period if he or she registered the trailer for 1 year and*
11 *renewed that registration for 2 consecutive years immediately*
12 *thereafter, including, without limitation:*

13 *(a) Registration fees pursuant to NRS 482.480 and 482.483.*

14 *(b) A fee for each license plate issued pursuant to*
15 *NRS 482.268.*

16 *(c) Fees for the initial issuance and renewal of a special*
17 *license plate pursuant to NRS 482.265, if applicable.*

18 *(d) Fees for the initial issuance and renewal of a personalized*
19 *prestige license plate pursuant to NRS 482.367, if applicable.*

20 *(e) Additional fees for the initial issuance and renewal of a*
21 *special license plate issued pursuant to NRS 482.3667 to 482.3823,*
22 *inclusive, which are imposed to generate financial support for a*
23 *particular cause or charitable organization, if applicable.*

24 *(f) Governmental services taxes imposed pursuant to chapter*
25 *371 of NRS, as provided in NRS 482.260.*

26 *(g) The applicable taxes imposed pursuant to chapters 372,*
27 *374, 377 and 377A of NRS.*



1 **3. As used in this section, the term “trailer” does not include**
2 **a full trailer or semitrailer that is registered pursuant to subsection**
3 **3 of NRS 482.483.**

4 **Sec. 1.5.** NRS 482.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:
5 482.010 As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise
6 requires, the words and terms defined in NRS 482.0105 to 482.137,
7 inclusive, **and section 1.2 of this act** have the meanings ascribed to
8 them in those sections.

9 **Sec. 2.** NRS 482.206 is hereby amended to read as follows:
10 482.206 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section ~~†~~
11 **and section 1.4 of this act**, every motor vehicle, except for a motor
12 vehicle that is registered pursuant to the provisions of NRS 706.801
13 to 706.861, inclusive, **and except for a full trailer or semitrailer**
14 **that is registered pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 482.483**, must
15 be registered for a period of 12 consecutive months beginning the
16 day after the first registration by the owner in this State.

17 2. ~~†Every†~~ **Except as otherwise provided in subsection 7 and**
18 **section 1.4 of this act**, every vehicle registered by an agent of the
19 Department or a registered dealer must be registered for 12
20 consecutive months beginning the first day of the month after the
21 first registration by the owner in this State.

22 3. ~~†A†~~ **Except as otherwise provided in subsection 7 and**
23 **section 1.4 of this act**, a vehicle which must be registered through
24 the Motor Carrier Division of the Department, or a motor vehicle
25 which has a declared gross weight in excess of 26,000 pounds, must
26 be registered for a period of 12 consecutive months beginning on the
27 date established by the Department by regulation.

28 4. Upon the application of the owner of a fleet of vehicles, the
29 Director may permit the owner to register the fleet on the basis of a
30 calendar year.

31 5. ~~†When†~~ **Except as otherwise provided in subsections 6 and**
32 **7, when** the registration of any vehicle is transferred pursuant to
33 NRS 482.399, the expiration date of each regular license plate,
34 special license plate or substitute decal must, at the time of the
35 transfer of registration, be advanced for a period of 12 consecutive
36 months beginning:

37 (a) The first day of the month after the transfer, if the vehicle is
38 transferred by an agent of the Department; or

39 (b) The day after the transfer in all other cases,
40 ➔ and a credit on the portion of the fee for registration and the
41 governmental services tax attributable to the remainder of
42 the current period of registration must be allowed pursuant to the
43 applicable provisions of NRS 482.399.

44 **6. When the registration of any trailer that is registered for a**
45 **3-year period pursuant to section 1.4 of this act is transferred**



1 *pursuant to NRS 482.399, the expiration date of each license plate*
2 *or substitute decal must, at the time of the transfer of the*
3 *registration, be advanced, if applicable pursuant to section 1.4 of*
4 *this act, for a period of 3 consecutive years beginning:*

5 *(a) The first day of the month after the transfer, if the trailer is*
6 *transferred by an agent of the Department; or*

7 *(b) The day after the transfer in all other cases,*

8 *↪ and a credit on the portion of the fee for registration and*
9 *the governmental services tax attributable to the remainder of the*
10 *current period of registration must be allowed pursuant to the*
11 *applicable provisions of NRS 482.399.*

12 *7. A full trailer or semitrailer that is registered pursuant to*
13 *subsection 3 of NRS 482.483 is registered until the date the owner*
14 *of the full trailer or semitrailer:*

15 *(a) Transfers the ownership of the full trailer or semitrailer; or*

16 *(b) Cancels the registration of the full trailer or semitrailer*
17 *and surrenders the license plates to the Department.*

18 **Sec. 3.** NRS 482.260 is hereby amended to read as follows:

19 482.260 1. When registering a vehicle, the Department and
20 its agents or a registered dealer shall:

21 (a) Collect the fees for license plates and registration as
22 provided for in this chapter.

23 (b) Collect the governmental services tax on the vehicle, as
24 agent for the State and for the county where the applicant intends to
25 base the vehicle for the period of registration, unless the vehicle is
26 deemed to have no base.

27 (c) Collect the applicable taxes imposed pursuant to chapters
28 372, 374, 377 and 377A of NRS.

29 (d) Issue a certificate of registration.

30 (e) If the registration is performed by the Department, issue the
31 regular license plate or plates.

32 (f) If the registration is performed by a registered dealer, provide
33 information to the owner regarding the manner in which the regular
34 license plate or plates will be made available to the owner.

35 2. Upon proof of ownership satisfactory to the Director, the
36 Director shall cause to be issued a certificate of title as provided in
37 this chapter.

38 3. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 371.070 ~~H~~ *and*
39 *subsections 6 and 7*, every vehicle being registered for the first time
40 in Nevada must be taxed for the purposes of the governmental
41 services tax for a 12-month period.

42 4. The Department shall deduct and withhold 2 percent of the
43 taxes collected pursuant to paragraph (c) of subsection 1 and remit
44 the remainder to the Department of Taxation.



1 5. A registered dealer shall forward all fees and taxes collected
2 for the registration of vehicles to the Department.

3 **6. A trailer being registered pursuant to section 1.4 of this act
4 must be taxed for the purposes of the governmental services tax
5 for a 3-year period.**

6 **7. A full trailer or semitrailer being registered pursuant to
7 subsection 3 of NRS 482.483 must be taxed for the purposes of the
8 governmental services tax in the amount of \$86. The
9 governmental services tax paid pursuant to this subsection is
10 nontransferable and nonrefundable. The Department shall remit
11 the governmental services tax collected pursuant to this subsection
12 to the Department of Taxation.**

13 **Sec. 4.** NRS 482.2705 is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 482.2705 1. The Director shall order the preparation of
15 vehicle license plates for passenger cars and trucks in the same
16 manner as is provided for motor vehicles generally in NRS 482.270.

17 2. Except as otherwise provided by specific statute, the
18 Director shall determine the combinations of letters and numbers
19 which constitute the designations for license plates assigned to
20 passenger cars and trucks.

21 3. Any license plate issued for a passenger car or truck before
22 January 1, 1982, bearing a designation which is not in conformance
23 with the system described in subsection 2 is valid during the period
24 for which the plate was originally issued as well as during any
25 ~~annual~~ extensions by stickers.

26 **Sec. 4.5.** NRS 482.274 is hereby amended to read as follows:

27 482.274 1. The Director shall order the preparation of vehicle
28 license plates for trailers in the same manner provided for motor
29 vehicles in NRS 482.270 ~~+~~, **except that a vehicle license plate
30 prepared for a full trailer or semitrailer that is registered pursuant
31 to subsection 3 of NRS 482.483 is not required to have displayed
32 upon it the month and year the registration expires.**

33 2. The Director shall order preparation of two sizes of vehicle
34 license plates for trailers. The smaller plates may be used for trailers
35 with a gross vehicle weight of less than 1,000 pounds.

36 3. The Director shall determine the registration numbers
37 assigned to trailers.

38 4. Any license plates issued for a trailer before July 1, 1975,
39 bearing a different designation from that provided for in this section,
40 are valid during the period for which such plates were issued.



1 **5. The Department shall not issue for a full trailer or**
2 **semitrailer that is registered pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS**
3 **482.483 a special license plate available pursuant to NRS**
4 **482.3667 to 482.3823, inclusive.**

5 **Sec. 5.** NRS 482.285 is hereby amended to read as follows:

6 482.285 1. If any certificate of registration or certificate of
7 title is lost, mutilated or illegible, the person to whom it was issued
8 shall immediately make application for and obtain a duplicate or
9 substitute therefor upon furnishing information satisfactory to the
10 Department and upon payment of the required fees.

11 2. If any license plate or plates or any decal is lost, mutilated or
12 illegible, the person to whom it was issued shall immediately make
13 application for and obtain:

14 (a) A duplicate number plate or a substitute number plate;

15 (b) A substitute decal; or

16 (c) A combination of both (a) and (b),

17 ➔ as appropriate, upon furnishing information satisfactory to the
18 Department and payment of the fees required by NRS 482.500.

19 3. If any license plate or plates or any decal is stolen, the
20 person to whom it was issued shall immediately make application
21 for and obtain:

22 (a) A substitute number plate;

23 (b) A substitute decal; or

24 (c) A combination of both (a) and (b),

25 ➔ as appropriate, upon furnishing information satisfactory to the
26 Department and payment of the fees required by NRS 482.500.

27 4. The Department shall issue duplicate number plates or
28 substitute number plates and, if applicable, a substitute decal, if the
29 applicant:

30 (a) Returns the mutilated or illegible plates to the Department or
31 signs a declaration that the plates were lost, mutilated or illegible;
32 and

33 (b) Complies with the provisions of subsection 6.

34 5. The Department shall issue substitute number plates and, if
35 applicable, a substitute decal, if the applicant:

36 (a) Signs a declaration that the plates were stolen; and

37 (b) Complies with the provisions of subsection 6.

38 6. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, an applicant
39 who desires duplicate number plates or substitute number plates
40 must make application for renewal of registration. ~~Credit~~ **Except**
41 **as otherwise provided in subsection 7 of NRS 482.260, credit** must
42 be allowed for the portion of the registration fee and governmental
43 services tax attributable to the remainder of the current registration
44 period. In lieu of making application for renewal of registration, an
45 applicant may elect to make application solely for:



1 (a) Duplicate number plates or substitute number plates, and a
2 substitute decal, if the previous license plates were lost, mutilated or
3 illegible; or

4 (b) Substitute number plates and a substitute decal, if the
5 previous license plates were stolen.

6 7. An applicant who makes the election described in subsection
7 6 retains the current date of expiration for the registration of the
8 applicable vehicle and is not, as a prerequisite to receiving duplicate
9 number plates or substitute number plates or a substitute decal,
10 required to:

11 (a) Submit evidence of compliance with controls over emission;
12 or

13 (b) Pay the registration fee and governmental services tax
14 attributable to a full ~~12-month~~ period of registration.

15 **Sec. 6.** NRS 482.3667 is hereby amended to read as follows:

16 482.3667 1. The Department shall establish, design and
17 otherwise prepare for issue personalized prestige license plates and
18 shall establish all necessary procedures not inconsistent with this
19 section for the application and issuance of such license plates.

20 2. The Department shall issue personalized prestige license
21 plates, upon payment of the prescribed fee, to any person who
22 otherwise complies with the laws relating to the registration and
23 licensing of motor vehicles or trailers for use on private passenger
24 cars, motorcycles, trucks or trailers ~~+~~, *except that such plates may*
25 *not be issued for a full trailer or semitrailer that is registered*
26 *pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 482.483.*

27 3. ~~Personalized~~ *Except as otherwise provided in section 1.4*
28 *of this act, personalized* prestige license plates are valid for 12
29 months and are renewable upon expiration. These plates may be
30 transferred from one vehicle or trailer to another if the transfer and
31 registration fees are paid as set out in this chapter.

32 4. In case of any conflict, the person who first made
33 application for personalized prestige license plates and has
34 continuously renewed them by payment of the required fee has
35 priority.

36 5. The Department may limit by regulation the number of
37 letters and numbers used and prohibit the use of inappropriate letters
38 or combinations of letters and numbers.

39 6. The Department shall not assign to any person not holding
40 the relevant office any letters and numbers denoting that the holder
41 holds a public office.

42 **Sec. 7.** NRS 482.367002 is hereby amended to read as
43 follows:

44 482.367002 1. A person may request that the Department
45 design, prepare and issue a special license plate by submitting an

1 application to the Department. A person may submit an application
2 for a special license plate that is intended to generate financial
3 support for an organization only if:

4 (a) For an organization which is not a governmental entity, the
5 organization is established as a nonprofit charitable organization
6 which provides services to the community relating to public health,
7 education or general welfare;

8 (b) For an organization which is a governmental entity, the
9 organization only uses the financial support generated by the special
10 license plate for charitable purposes relating to public health,
11 education or general welfare;

12 (c) The organization is registered with the Secretary of State, if
13 registration is required by law, and has filed any documents required
14 to remain registered with the Secretary of State;

15 (d) The name and purpose of the organization do not promote,
16 advertise or endorse any specific product, brand name or service that
17 is offered for profit;

18 (e) The organization is nondiscriminatory; and

19 (f) The license plate will not promote a specific religion, faith or
20 antireligious belief.

21 2. An application submitted to the Department pursuant to
22 subsection 1:

23 (a) Must be on a form prescribed and furnished by the
24 Department;

25 (b) Must specify whether the special license plate being
26 requested is intended to generate financial support for a particular
27 cause or charitable organization and, if so, the name of the cause or
28 charitable organization;

29 (c) Must include proof that the organization satisfies the
30 requirements set forth in subsection 1;

31 (d) Must be accompanied by a surety bond posted with the
32 Department in the amount of \$5,000; and

33 (e) May be accompanied by suggestions for the design of and
34 colors to be used in the special license plate.

35 3. The Department may design and prepare a special license
36 plate requested pursuant to subsection 1 if:

37 (a) The Department determines that the application for that plate
38 complies with subsection 2; and

39 (b) The Commission on Special License Plates approves the
40 application for that plate pursuant to subsection 5 of
41 NRS 482.367004.

42 4. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 482.367008, the
43 Department may issue a special license plate that:

44 (a) The Department has designed and prepared pursuant to this
45 section;



1 (b) The Commission on Special License Plates has approved for
2 issuance pursuant to subsection 5 of NRS 482.367004; and

3 (c) Complies with the requirements of subsection 7 of
4 NRS 482.270,

5 ➔ for any passenger car or light commercial vehicle upon
6 application by a person who is entitled to license plates pursuant to
7 NRS 482.265 and who otherwise complies with the requirements for
8 registration and licensing pursuant to this chapter. A person may
9 request that personalized prestige license plates issued pursuant to
10 NRS 482.3667 be combined with a special license plate issued
11 pursuant to this section if that person pays the fees for personalized
12 prestige license plates in addition to the fees for the special license
13 plate.

14 5. The Department must promptly release the surety bond
15 posted pursuant to subsection 2:

16 (a) If the Department or the Commission on Special License
17 Plates determines not to issue the special license plate; or

18 (b) If it is determined that at least 1,000 special license plates
19 have been issued pursuant to the assessment of the viability of the
20 design of the special license plate conducted pursuant to
21 NRS 482.367008.

22 6. If, during a registration ~~year,~~ *period*, the holder of license
23 plates issued pursuant to the provisions of this section disposes of
24 the vehicle to which the plates are affixed, the holder shall:

25 (a) Retain the plates and affix them to another vehicle that meets
26 the requirements of this section if the holder pays the fee for the
27 transfer of the registration and any registration fee or governmental
28 services tax due pursuant to NRS 482.399; or

29 (b) Within 30 days after removing the plates from the vehicle,
30 return them to the Department.

31 **Sec. 8.** NRS 482.3747 is hereby amended to read as follows:

32 482.3747 1. The Department, in cooperation with the Board
33 of Regents and the athletic departments of the University of Nevada,
34 Reno, and the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, shall design,
35 prepare and issue collegiate license plates, using any appropriate
36 colors and designs to represent each university.

37 2. The Department may issue collegiate license plates for any
38 passenger car or light commercial vehicle upon application by any
39 person who is entitled to license plates pursuant to NRS 482.265
40 and who otherwise complies with the requirements for registration
41 and licensing pursuant to this chapter. A person may request that
42 personalized prestige license plates issued pursuant to NRS
43 482.3667 be combined with collegiate license plates if that person
44 pays the fees for the personalized prestige license plates in addition



1 to the fees for the collegiate license plates pursuant to subsections 3
2 and 4.

3 3. The fee for the collegiate license plates is \$35, in addition to
4 all other applicable registration and license fees and governmental
5 services taxes. Collegiate license plates are renewable upon the
6 payment of \$10.

7 4. In addition to all fees for the license, registration and
8 governmental services taxes, a person who requests a collegiate
9 license plate shall pay for the initial issuance of a plate an additional
10 fee of \$25 and for each renewal of the plate an additional fee of \$20
11 for academic and athletic scholarships to students of the University
12 of Nevada, Reno, and the University of Nevada, Las Vegas.

13 5. The Department shall deposit the fees collected pursuant to
14 subsection 4 with the State Treasurer for credit to the Collegiate
15 License Plate Account in the State General Fund created pursuant to
16 NRS 396.384.

17 6. If, during a registration ~~year,~~ *period*, the holder of
18 collegiate plates issued pursuant to the provisions of this section
19 disposes of the vehicle to which the plates are affixed, the holder
20 may retain the plates and:

21 (a) Affix them to another vehicle which meets the requirements
22 of this section if the transfer and registration fees are paid as set out
23 in this chapter; or

24 (b) Within 30 days after removing the plates from the vehicle,
25 return them to the Department.

26 **Sec. 9.** NRS 482.3748 is hereby amended to read as follows:

27 482.3748 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the
28 Department, in cooperation with the Grand Lodge of Free and
29 Accepted Masons of the State of Nevada, shall design, prepare and
30 issue license plates that indicate affiliation with the Grand Lodge of
31 Free and Accepted Masons using any colors and designs which the
32 Department deems appropriate. The Department shall not design,
33 prepare or issue the license plates unless it receives at least 250
34 applications for the issuance of those plates.

35 2. The Department shall issue license plates that indicate
36 affiliation with the Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons for a
37 passenger car or a light commercial vehicle upon application by a
38 person who is entitled to license plates pursuant to NRS 482.265
39 and who otherwise complies with the requirements for registration
40 and licensing pursuant to this chapter. A person may request that
41 personalized prestige license plates issued pursuant to NRS
42 482.3667 be combined with license plates that indicate affiliation
43 with the Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons if that person
44 pays the fees for the personalized prestige license plates in addition



1 to the fees for the license plates that indicate affiliation with the
2 Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons.

3 3. An application for the issuance or renewal of license plates
4 that indicate affiliation with the Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted
5 Masons is void unless it has been stamped or otherwise validated by
6 the Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons. The Grand Lodge
7 of Free and Accepted Masons may charge a fee for validating an
8 application.

9 4. The fee payable to the Department for license plates that
10 indicate affiliation with the Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted
11 Masons is \$35, in addition to all other applicable registration and
12 license fees and governmental services taxes. The license plates are
13 renewable upon the payment to the Department of \$10 in addition to
14 all other applicable registration and license fees and governmental
15 services taxes.

16 5. If, during a registration ~~year,~~ *period*, the holder of license
17 plates issued pursuant to the provisions of this section disposes of
18 the vehicle to which the plates are affixed, the holder may retain the
19 plates and:

20 (a) Affix them to another vehicle that meets the requirements of
21 this section if the transfer and registration fees are paid as set out in
22 this chapter; or

23 (b) Within 30 days after removing the plates from the vehicle,
24 return them to the Department.

25 6. For the purposes of this section, "Grand Lodge of Free and
26 Accepted Masons" means the Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted
27 Masons of the State of Nevada, or its successor, and any recognized
28 sister jurisdiction or organization of the Grand Lodge of Free and
29 Accepted Masons.

30 **Sec. 10.** NRS 482.3749 is hereby amended to read as follows:

31 482.3749 1. The Department shall, in cooperation with the
32 Nevada Commission on Sports and using any colors and designs
33 that the Department deems appropriate, design, prepare and issue
34 license plates which indicate status as a hall of fame athlete. The
35 design of the license plates must include the words "hall of fame."

36 2. The Department shall issue license plates that indicate status
37 as a hall of fame athlete for a passenger car or a light commercial
38 vehicle upon application by a person who is entitled to license plates
39 pursuant to NRS 482.265 and who otherwise complies with the
