AN ACT relating to programs for public personnel; requiring the Board of the Public Employees’ Benefits Program to create a certain pilot program in certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Existing law creates the Board of the Public Employees’ Benefits Program.
2 (NRS 287.041) Under existing law, the Board is required to establish and carry out
3 the Public Employees’ Benefits Program which includes a program relating to
4 group life, accident or health insurance, or any combination thereof, for the benefit
5 of state officers and employees and other participants. (NRS 287.043) This bill
6 requires the Board, to the extent that it determines money is available, to create a
7 pilot program to establish one or more clinics to provide primary care services to
8 persons who participate in the Program. If the pilot program is created, this bill
9 requires the Board to: (1) solicit feedback from persons who use the services of
10 such a clinic; and (2) report annually to the Legislature concerning the pilot
11 program.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 287 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *1. To the extent that the Board determines money is available,*
4 *the Board shall create a pilot program to establish one or more*
5 *clinics to provide primary care services to persons who participate*
6 *in the Program.*



1 **2. The Board shall solicit feedback regarding the pilot**
2 **program from persons who use the services provided at such a**
3 **clinic.**

4 **3. Within one year after the creation of the pilot program,**
5 **and annually thereafter, the Board shall submit to the Director of**
6 **the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the Legislature,**
7 **if the Legislature is in session, or to the Interim Finance**
8 **Committee, if the Legislature is not in session, a report concerning**
9 **the pilot program. The report must include, without limitation:**

10 **(a) A description of the status and results of the pilot program;**

11 **(b) The costs of carrying out the pilot program;**

12 **(c) A summary of the feedback provided pursuant to**
13 **subsection 2; and**

14 **(d) Recommendations for legislation to improve or expand the**
15 **pilot program.**

16 **Sec. 2.** NRS 287.0402 is hereby amended to read as follows:

17 287.0402 As used in NRS 287.0402 to 287.049, inclusive, **and**
18 **section 1 of this act**, unless the context otherwise requires, the
19 words and terms defined in NRS 287.0404 to 287.04064, inclusive,
20 have the meanings ascribed to them in those sections.

21 **Sec. 3.** The provisions of subsection 1 of NRS 218D.380 do
22 not apply to any provision of this act which adds or revises a
23 requirement to submit a report to the Legislature.

24 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
