SUMMARY—Requires that any additional revenue projected by the Economic Forum in its May report be appropriated for the support of public education. (BDR S-969)

AN ACT relating to state financial administration; requiring the Fiscal Analysis Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau to determine the difference between the December and May revenue projections of the Economic Forum; requiring the Senate Standing Committee on Finance and the Assembly Standing Committee on Ways and Means to allocate any increase in projected revenue for the support of the State Distributive School Account and the Nevada System of Higher Education; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

The Economic Forum is required to project revenues for the ensuing biennium in December preceding a regular session of the Nevada Legislature and to adjust those projections in May of the session year. (NRS 353.228) The Governor is required to use the December projections in preparing and submitting the proposed budget. (NRS 353.230) This bill requires the Fiscal Analysis Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau to report to the Senate Standing Committee on Finance and the Assembly Standing Committee on Ways and Means the difference between the December projection of revenues and the May projection of revenues for each fiscal year of the ensuing biennium. Those committees are required to allocate 60 percent of any additional revenue projected for a fiscal year to the State Distributive School Account, which provides state support for local school districts, and the remaining 40 percent of any additional revenue projected for a fiscal year to the Nevada System of Higher Education.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. As soon as practicable after the Economic
2 Forum prepares the report required pursuant to paragraph (e) of
3 subsection 1 of NRS 353.228, the Fiscal Analysis Division of the
4 Legislative Counsel Bureau shall determine the net change in
5 the projection of state revenue between the amounts projected by the
6 report prepared pursuant to paragraph (e) of subsection 1 of NRS
7 353.228 and the projections of revenues made pursuant to paragraph
8 (d) of subsection 1 of NRS 353.228 for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 and
9 Fiscal Year 2012-2013. The Fiscal Analysis Division shall report
10 the amount of the net change for each Fiscal Year to the Senate
11 Standing Committee on Finance and the Assembly Standing
12 Committee on Ways and Means.

13 2. If the amount reported for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 or Fiscal
14 Year 2012-2013 pursuant to subsection 1 reflects a projected
15 increase in revenue, the Senate Standing Committee on Finance and
16 the Assembly Standing Committee on Ways and Means shall adjust
17 the budgets for the State Distributive School Account created
18 pursuant to NRS 387.030 and the Nevada System of Higher
19 Education by allocating 60 percent of the projected increase to the
20 State Distributive School Account and 40 percent of the projected
21 increase to the Nevada System of Higher Education.

22 3. The Legislature intends that any allocation pursuant to this
23 section supplement the amounts otherwise appropriated or
24 authorized for the support of education. The budgets for the State
25 Distributive School Account and the Nevada System of Higher
26 Education must not be reduced in any amount to offset an additional
27 allocation pursuant to this section, and the allocations must not be
28 used to replace or supplant funding that would otherwise be
29 provided for the State Distributive School Account or the Nevada
30 System of Higher Education.

31 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
