**SUMMARY**—Revises the requirements concerning background investigations of certain applicants for employment or contracts with private postsecondary educational institutions. (BDR 34-442)

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AN ACT relating to private postsecondary educational institutions; revising the requirements concerning background investigations of certain applicants for employment or contracts with private postsecondary educational institutions; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 Existing law requires certain persons who apply for employment or a contract  
2 with a private postsecondary educational institution to submit a completed  
3 fingerprint card that must be taken by an agency of law enforcement and  
4 authorization for the postsecondary institution to conduct an investigation of the  
5 background of the applicants. (NRS 394.465) This bill allows the fingerprint card  
6 and authorization to be submitted electronically to the Central Repository for  
7 Nevada Records of Criminal History. This bill also exempts an applicant from the  
8 background check if: (1) the applicant will provide instruction from a location  
9 outside this State through a licensed program of distance education; (2) the  
10 applicant previously underwent a background check; and (3) the Administrator of  
11 the Commission on Postsecondary Education determines that an additional  
12 background check is not necessary.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** NRS 394.465 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2       394.465 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection ~~[4.]~~ **6,**  
3 before a postsecondary educational institution employs or contracts  
4 with a person:

- 5       (a) To occupy an instructional position;  
6       (b) To occupy an administrative or financial position, including

30 *permission to the law enforcement agency or other authorized*  
31 *entity taking the fingerprints to submit the fingerprints to the*

6 ~~[4.]~~ 6. An applicant is not required to satisfy the requirements  
7 of ~~[subsection 1]~~ *this section* if the applicant:

8 (a) Is licensed by the Superintendent of Public Instruction;

9 (b) Is an employee of the United States Department of Defense;

10 (c) Is a member of the faculty of an accredited postsecondary  
11 educational institution in another state who is domiciled in a state  
12 other than Nevada and is present in Nevada for a temporary period  
13 to teach at a branch of that accredited institution; ~~[or]~~

14 (d) *Is an instructor who provides instruction from a location*  
15 *outside this State through a program of distance education for a*  
16 *postsecondary educational institution licensed by the Commission*  
17 *who previously underwent an investigation of his or her*  
18 *background and the Administrator determines that an additional*  
19 *investigation is not necessary; or*

20 (e) Has satisfied the requirements of subsection 1 within the  
21 immediately preceding 5 years.

22 7. *As used in this section, "distance education" means*  
23 *instruction delivered by means of video, computer, television, or*  
24 *the Internet or other electronic means of communication, or any*  
25 *combination thereof, in such a manner that the person supervising*  
26 *or providing the instruction and the student receiving the*  
27 *instruction are separated geographically.*
