ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 455-COMMITTEE ON REVENUE

SUMMARY—Authorizes the imposition of a civil penalty by the Department of Taxation for certain violations relating to contraband tobacco products. (BDR 32-1068)

AN ACT relating to tobacco; authorizing the Department of Taxation to impose a civil penalty for certain violations relating to contraband tobacco products; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law: (1) prohibits a person from knowingly selling or possessing for 2345678 the purpose of selling any contraband tobacco products; and (2) provides that any person who exports, imports, possesses or constructively possesses contraband tobacco products, with certain exceptions, is guilty of a gross misdemeanor. (NRS 370.405, 370.410) Existing law also requires the Department of Taxation and its agents, sheriffs and all other peace officers of this State to seize any counterfeit stamps, contraband tobacco products, machinery used to manufacture contraband tobacco products and cigarette rolling machines used in violation of existing law 9 that are found in this State. (NRS 370.415) This bill authorizes the Department to impose a civil penalty on any person who violates such provisions of existing law resulting in the seizure of counterfeit stamps, contraband tobacco products, 10 11 machinery or cigarette rolling machines. This bill further requires any civil penalty 12 13 to be credited to a separate account in the State General Fund to be used to enforce 14 the provisions governing contraband tobacco products.





THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 370.415 is hereby amended to read as follows: 370.415 1. The Department, its agents, sheriffs within their 2 3 respective counties and all other peace officers of the State of Nevada shall seize any counterfeit stamps, contraband tobacco 4 products, machinery used to manufacture contraband tobacco 5 products and cigarette rolling machines being used in violation of 6 7 any provision of this chapter that are found or located in the State of 8 Nevada.

9 2. A sheriff or other peace officer who seizes stamps, 10 contraband tobacco products, machinery or cigarette rolling 11 machines pursuant to this section shall provide written notification 12 of the seizure to the Department not later than 5 working days after 13 the seizure. The notification must include the reason for the seizure.

14 3. After consultation with the Department, the sheriff or other 15 peace officer shall transmit the contraband tobacco products to the 16 Department if:

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(a) The contraband tobacco products consist of cigarettes and:

18 (1) Except for revenue stamps being properly affixed as 19 required by this chapter, the cigarettes comply with all state and 20 federal statutes and regulations; and

21 (2) The Department approves the transmission of the 22 cigarettes; or

(b) The contraband tobacco products consist of any other
 tobacco products and the Department approves the transmission of
 the other tobacco products.

26 4. Upon the receipt of any:

(a) Cigarettes pursuant to subsection 3, the Department shall
dispose of the cigarettes as provided in subsection 4 of NRS
370.270; or

30 (b) Other tobacco products pursuant to subsection 3, the 31 Department shall:

(1) Sell the other tobacco products to the highest bidder
among the licensed wholesale dealers in this State after due notice to
all licensed Nevada wholesale dealers has been given by mail to the
addresses contained in the Department's records; or

(2) If there is no bidder, or in the opinion of the Department
the quantity of the other tobacco products is insufficient, or for any
other reason such disposition would be impractical, destroy or
dispose of the other tobacco products as the Department may see fit.

40 \rightarrow The proceeds of all sales pursuant to this paragraph must be 41 classed as revenues derived under the provisions of NRS 370.440 to 42 370.503, inclusive.





1 5. The sheriff or other peace officer who seizes any stamps, 2 contraband tobacco products, machinery or cigarette rolling 3 machines pursuant to this section shall:

4 (a) Destroy the stamps, machinery and cigarette rolling 5 machines; and

6 (b) If he or she does not transmit the contraband tobacco 7 products to the Department, destroy the contraband tobacco 8 products.

9 In addition to any other penalty provided by law, the **6**. Department may impose a civil penalty upon a person who violates 10 NRS 370.405 or 370.410 resulting in the seizure of counterfeit 11 stamps, contraband tobacco products, machinery or cigarette 12 13 rolling machines pursuant to this section in amount determined by the Department which may not exceed the greater of \$25,000 or 14 the total costs incurred by the Department for the transportation, 15 storage and disposal of the counterfeit stamps, contraband tobacco 16 17 products, machinery or cigarette rolling machines. All penalties imposed pursuant to subsection 6 must be 18 7. paid to the Department in the form of remittances payable to the 19 20 Department and deposited in a separate account in the State
