SUMMARY—Prohibits the opening of a charter school for a prescribed period. (BDR S-1090)

AN ACT relating to education; prohibiting the approval of an application to operate a charter school or the execution of a charter contract with the governing body of a new charter school for a prescribed time period; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law authorizes the board of trustees of a school district or a college or university within the Nevada System of Higher Education that has been approved to sponsor a charter school or the State Public Charter School Authority to approve an application to form a charter school and enter into a charter contract with the governing body of the charter school. (NRS 388A.252, 388A.270) This bill prohibits those entities from accepting or approving such an application or entering into a charter contract with the governing body of a new charter school until January 1, 2021.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of NRS 388A.252, 388A.255 or 388A.270, the board of trustees of a school district, a college or university within the Nevada System of Higher Education or the State Public Charter School Authority shall not accept or approve an application to form a charter school or execute a charter contract with the governing body of a new charter school until January 1, 2021.
