

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 467—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION)

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Division of State Parks of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to purchase new equipment and replace public safety equipment and worn and obsolete equipment. (BDR S-1185)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Division of State Parks of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to purchase new equipment and replace public safety equipment and worn and obsolete equipment; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
2 Fund to the Division of State Parks of the State Department of
3 Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of \$371,023 for the
4 purchase of new equipment and the replacement of public safety
5 equipment and equipment that is worn and obsolete, including
6 replacing motors for watercraft for patrol and rescue units and
7 replacing law enforcement and utility vehicles.

8 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
9 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
10 June 30, 2015, by the Division of State Parks of the State
11 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources or any entity to
12 which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise



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1 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated
2 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
3 September 18, 2015, by either the Division of State Parks or the
4 entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred,
5 and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before
6 September 18, 2015.

7 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
