SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to the system modernization project of the Department of Motor Vehicles. (BDR S-910)

EXPLANATION - Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets {omitted material} is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to the Department of Motor Vehicles; authorizing the carrying forward to Fiscal Year 2017-2018 and Fiscal Year 2018-2019 of certain money appropriated for the system modernization project of the Department of Motor Vehicles; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Senate Bill No. 514 of the 78th Session of the Nevada Legislature made 1 23456789 appropriations from the State Highway Fund to the System Modernization account within the Department of Motor Vehicles for Fiscal Years 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 for the Department to use to modernize its existing information technology platform. Senate Bill No. 514 also appropriated additional money from the State Highway Fund to the Interim Finance Committee for Fiscal Years 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 for allocation to the System Modernization account for the costs of software implementation for the system modernization project. Senate Bill No. 514 requires that any remaining balance of the money appropriated to the Interim 10 Finance Committee not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2017, and that 11 any remaining portion of the appropriated money not be spent for any purpose after 12 13 September 15, 2017. Instead, any remaining portion of the appropriated money is required to be reverted to the State Highway Fund on or before September 15, 14 2017. (Sections 33 and 83 of chapter 534, Statutes of Nevada 2015, pp. 3677, 3690)

This bill carries forward to Fiscal Years 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 the sum of \$811,183 of the money that was appropriated to the Interim Finance Committee for allocation in Fiscal Year 2016-2017 for the costs of software implementation for the system modernization project and which is unallocated or unexpended at the





end of Fiscal Year 2016-2017. This bill also authorizes use of that money in Fiscal Years 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 to make any remaining payments to the vendor that performed the software implementation work which were retained pending satisfactory completion of the work. Finally, this bill requires any balance of the \$811,183 remaining at the end of Fiscal Year 2018-2019 to be reverted to the State Highway Fund on or before September 20, 2019. The approval of the Interim Finance Committee is not required for any request for the revision of a work program to carry forward the money. (NRS 353.220)

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of section 83 of chapter 534, Statutes of Nevada 2015, at page 3690, the sum of 2 \$811,183 of the appropriation made to the Interim Finance 3 Committee for allocation in Fiscal Year 2016-2017 to the 4 5 Department of Motor Vehicles that is unallocated or unexpended at the end of Fiscal Year 2016-2017 does not revert to the State 6 Highway Fund, must be carried forward to Fiscal Years 2017-2018 7 and 2018-2019 and is hereby authorized for use in Fiscal Years 8 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 to make any remaining payments to the 9 10 vendor that performed the software implementation work which 11 were retained pending satisfactory completion of the work.

12 2. Any remaining balance of the money described in subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2019, by 13 either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity 14 to which the money was subsequently allocated, granted or otherwise transferred. Any portion of the money described in 15 16 subsection 1 remaining must not be spent for any purpose after 17 September 20, 2019, by either the entity to which the money was 18 19 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently 20 allocated, granted or otherwise transferred, and must be reverted to the State Highway Fund on or before September 20, 2019. 21
