SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to pesticides.
(BDR 51-265)

AN ACT relating to pesticides; revising requirements relating to the maintenance of certain records of restricted-use pesticides; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 The United States Environmental Protection Agency delegates the primary
2 responsibility of implementing the Certification of Pesticide Applicators Rules to
3 states through State certification plans. (7 U.S.C. § 136i) Existing federal
4 regulations impose certain recordkeeping requirements on restricted-use pesticide
5 dealers. (40 C.F.R. § 171.303) The Nevada Pesticides Act requires registered
6 sellers of restricted-use pesticides to maintain records of all sales for 2 years and to
7 submit a monthly report to the Director of the State Department of Agriculture
8 specifying the restricted-use pesticides sold during the previous month. (NRS
9 586.406) Restricted-use pesticides are defined in existing law as any pesticides that:
10 (1) the Director of the State Department of Agriculture has determined to be
11 injurious or detrimental to certain animals, crops, land or public health and safety;
12 or (2) have been classified for restricted use by or under the supervision of a
13 certified applicator in accordance with federal law. (NRS 586.205) This bill
14 requires registered sellers to maintain records for 2 years of each distribution of
15 restricted-use pesticides, in addition to the sales, and revises the requirements for
16 monthly reports of sales to the Director to also include distributions of restricted-
17 use pesticides. Additionally, this bill requires that the records of sales and
18 distributions be made in accordance with the federal recordkeeping requirements
19 for State certification plans.



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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 586.406 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 586.406 1. It is unlawful for any person to sell or offer to sell
3 at the retail level or distribute or deliver for transportation for
4 delivery to the consumer or user a pesticide classified for restricted
5 use pursuant to NRS 586.237 or the Federal Environmental
6 Pesticide Control Act, 7 U.S.C. §§ 136 et seq., unless the person is
7 registered with the Director.

8 2. Each person applying for registration must provide a
9 statement including:

10 (a) The name and address of the person registering; and

11 (b) The name and address of any person who, on behalf of the
12 person registering, sells, offers to sell, distributes or delivers for
13 transportation a restricted-use pesticide.

14 3. All registrations expire on December 31 and are renewable
15 annually.

16 4. Each person registering shall pay:

17 (a) An annual registration fee established by regulation of the
18 State Board of Agriculture; and

19 (b) A penalty fee of \$5 if the person's previous registration has
20 expired by the failure to reregister on or before February 1, unless
21 the person's registration is accompanied by a signed statement that
22 no person named on the registration statement has sold or
23 distributed any restricted-use pesticides during the year the
24 registration was not in effect.

25 5. Each person who is registered shall maintain for 2 years a
26 record of ~~all sales~~ **each sale and distribution** of restricted-use
27 pesticides ~~showing:~~

28 ~~(a) The date of sale or delivery;~~

29 ~~(b) The name and address of the person to whom sold or
30 delivered;~~

31 ~~(c) The brand name of the pesticide product;~~

32 ~~(d) The amount of pesticide product sold or delivered;~~

33 ~~(e) The certification number of the certified applicator who is
34 applying or supervising the application of the pesticide if the
35 purchaser of the pesticide is not certified to apply the pesticide; and~~

36 ~~(f) Such other information as may be required by the Director.]~~
37 ***in accordance with the requirements for State certification plans
38 set forth in 40 C.F.R. § 171.303(b)(7)(vii).***

39 6. Each person registered pursuant to this section shall, on or
40 before the 15th day of each month, file a report with the Director
41 specifying the restricted-use pesticides sold **or distributed** during the
42 previous month. The Director shall provide the form for the report.



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- 1 The form must be filed regardless of whether the person sold **or**
- 2 **distributed** any pesticides during the previous month.
- 3 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
