

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 8—COMMITTEE

SUMMARY—Revises the composition of a metropolitan police committee on fiscal affairs. (BDR 22-396)

AN ACT relating to metropolitan police departments; revising the membership of a metropolitan police committee on fiscal affairs to add one additional member from the participating political subdivision that is a county; making the member selected by the committee from the general public a nonvoting member; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Existing law establishes a metropolitan police committee on fiscal affairs in a
2 county which has established a metropolitan police department and sets forth the
3 membership as two representatives from each participating political subdivision
4 and one member selected by the committee from the general public. (NRS 280.010,
5 280.080, 280.130) **Section 1** of this bill: (1) adds to the committee one additional
6 member from a participating political subdivision that is a county; and (2) makes
7 the member selected by the committee from the general public a nonvoting
8 member. **Section 2** of this bill provides that the person who is a member of the
9 committee from the general public continues to be a voting member until that
10 member’s successor is selected.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 280.130 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 280.130 1. The committee consists of ~~two~~:



1 (a) *Three* representatives from ~~each~~ *the* participating political
2 subdivision ~~that is a county; and~~

3 (b) *Two representatives from each participating political*
4 *subdivision that is not a county.*

5 2. Representatives of the participating political subdivisions are
6 not entitled to receive any additional compensation or be reimbursed
7 by the department for any expenses incurred while serving on the
8 committee.

9 3. Each representative of a participating political subdivision
10 must be a member of its governing body and serves at the pleasure
11 of the governing body making the appointment.

12 4. The members of the committee shall, by majority vote,
13 select an additional, *nonvoting* member of the committee from the
14 general public from a list consisting of three persons nominated by
15 each participating political subdivision and three persons nominated
16 by the sheriff. That person:

17 (a) Must reside in the area served by the department.

18 (b) Shall serve until August 1 next succeeding and until a
19 successor is selected.

20 (c) May succeed himself or herself.

21 (d) Is entitled to receive as compensation \$40 for each day of
22 service.

23 (e) Is entitled to reimbursement for necessary travel and per
24 diem expenses in the manner provided by the committee for the
25 reimbursement of officers and employees of the department.

26 5. If the members of the committee fail to agree on the
27 additional member to be selected pursuant to subsection 4 within 30
28 days after their initial meeting following the merger or by August 1
29 of any year thereafter, the additional member of the committee must
30 be appointed by the Governor without regard to the lists submitted.
31 The person so appointed must reside in the area served by the
32 department.

33 6. At its first meeting and in August of each year thereafter, the
34 committee shall select one of its members to act as chair.

35 **Sec. 2.** 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 4 of
36 NRS 280.130, as amended by section 1 of this act, the person who is
37 a member of the committee from the general public on June 30,
38 2023, continues to be a voting member of the committee until that
39 member's successor is selected pursuant to NRS 280.130, as
40 amended by section 1 of this act.

41 2. As used in this section, "committee" has the meaning
42 ascribed to it in NRS 280.045.

43 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2023.
