

ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 7–
ASSEMBLYWOMAN NEAL

SUMMARY—Directs the Legislative Commission to conduct an interim study concerning property taxes. (BDR R-1049)

ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Directing the Legislative Commission to appoint a committee to conduct an interim study concerning property taxes.

- 1 WHEREAS, Section 1 of Article 10 of the Nevada Constitution
2 requires the Legislature to provide by law for the taxation of
3 property in this State; and
4 WHEREAS, The Legislature desires to base the discharge of its
5 constitutional duties on the best information possible; and
6 WHEREAS, A thorough legislative study of property taxes is in
7 the interest of the people of this State; now, therefore, be it
8 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE
9 SENATE CONCURRING, That the Legislative Commission is hereby
10 directed to appoint a committee to conduct an interim study
11 concerning property taxes, which must be composed of six
12 Legislators as follows:
13 1. The Chair of the Assembly Standing Committee on Taxation
14 during the 2017 Legislative Session;
15 2. One member appointed by the Speaker of the Assembly
16 from the membership of the Assembly Standing Committee on
17 Taxation during the 2017 Legislative Session;
18 3. One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the
19 Assembly from the membership of the Assembly Standing
20 Committee on Taxation during the 2017 Legislative Session;
21 4. The Chair of the Senate Standing Committee on Revenue
22 and Economic Development during the 2017 Legislative Session;



1 5. One member appointed by the Majority Leader of the Senate
2 from the membership of the Senate Standing Committee on
3 Revenue and Economic Development during the 2017 Legislative
4 Session; and

5 6. One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate
6 from the membership of the Senate Standing Committee on
7 Revenue and Economic Development during the 2017 Legislative
8 Session; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Commission shall designate
10 one of the members appointed to the committee to serve as the Chair
11 of the committee; and be it further

12 RESOLVED, That if any member of the committee informs the
13 Chair of the committee that the member will be unable to attend a
14 particular meeting, the Chair shall notify the Speaker of the
15 Assembly or the Majority Leader of the Senate, as the case may be,
16 to appoint an alternate for that meeting from the same House and
17 political party as the absent member; and be it further

18 RESOLVED, That any recommended legislation proposed by the
19 committee must be approved by a majority of the members of the
20 Assembly and a majority of the members of the Senate appointed to
21 the committee; and be it further

22 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Commission shall submit a
23 report of the results of the study and any recommendations for
24 legislation to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for
25 transmittal to the 80th Session of the Nevada Legislature; and be it
26 further

27 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly prepare and
28 transmit a copy of this resolution to the Executive Director of the
29 Department of Taxation.
