ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION—Urging Congress to sell or transfer certain public lands to local governmental agencies and nonprofit organizations.

WHEREAS, The Federal Government manages and controls over
80 percent of the land in this State; and

WHEREAS, The Federal Government has leased certain public lands to state and local governmental agencies and nonprofit organizations for recreational or public purposes; and

6 WHEREAS, State and local governmental agencies and nonprofit 7 organizations have constructed permanent public infrastructure on 8 certain leased public lands; and

9 WHEREAS, A lack of coordination between the Federal 10 Government and the state and local governmental agencies and 11 nonprofit organizations over the control and management of these 12 lands can thwart positive land management outcomes; and

WHEREAS, The sale or transfer of these public lands to state and local governmental agencies and nonprofit organizations can improve land management outcomes and help conserve state, local and federal resources by streamlining the decision-making process and reducing potential conflict; now, therefore, be it





1 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY AND SENATE OF THE STATE OF 2 NEVADA, JOINTLY, That the 81st Session of the Nevada Legislature 3 supports the sale or transfer of these public lands on which 4 permanent public infrastructure has been built to the state and local 5 governmental agencies and nonprofit organizations that currently 6 lease these public lands; and be it further

7 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly prepare and 8 transmit a copy of this resolution to the Vice President of the United 9 States as the presiding officer of the United States Senate, the 10 Speaker of the United States House of Representatives and each 11 member of the Nevada Congressional Delegation; and be it further

12 RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective upon 13 passage.
