## SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to capital improvement projects. (BDR S-9)

EXPLANATION - Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

# AN ACT relating to projects of capital improvement; revising the funding for certain projects; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

#### Legislative Counsel's Digest:

During the 2017 and 2019 Legislative Sessions, the Legislature authorized the 1 2345678 State Board of Finance to issue general obligation bonds of the State of Nevada for certain projects of capital improvement. (Section 6 of chapter 606, Statutes of Nevada 2017, at p. 4440; section 6 of chapter 542, Statutes of Nevada 2019, at p. 3309) Sections 1 and 2 of this bill revise the amount of the proceeds of these general obligation bonds that are allocated to certain projects of capital improvement. Section 3 of this bill provides for the reversion to the State General Fund of certain amounts appropriated by the Legislature for certain projects of ğ capital improvement. Sections 4 and 5 of this bill require the Department of 10 Administration, upon the approval of the Chief of the Budget Division of the Office 11 of Finance, to ensure that appropriate adjustments are made to the capital 12 improvement projects revised pursuant to sections 1 and 2 of this bill to ensure the 13 occurrence of certain reversions of appropriations made from the State General 14 Fund for projects of capital improvement approved during the 2017 and 2019 15 Legislative Sessions.
