SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to capital improvement projects. (BDR S-9)

AN ACT relating to projects of capital improvement; revising the funding for certain projects; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 During the 2017 and 2019 Legislative Sessions, the Legislature authorized the
2 State Board of Finance to issue general obligation bonds of the State of Nevada for
3 certain projects of capital improvement. (Section 6 of chapter 606, Statutes of
4 Nevada 2017, at p. 4440; section 6 of chapter 542, Statutes of Nevada 2019, at p.
5 3309) **Sections 1 and 2** of this bill revise the amount of the proceeds of these
6 general obligation bonds that are allocated to certain projects of capital
7 improvement. **Section 3** of this bill provides for the reversion to the State General
8 Fund of certain amounts appropriated by the Legislature for certain projects of
9 capital improvement. **Sections 4 and 5** of this bill require the Department of
10 Administration, upon the approval of the Chief of the Budget Division of the Office
11 of Finance, to ensure that appropriate adjustments are made to the capital
12 improvement projects revised pursuant to **sections 1 and 2** of this bill to ensure the
13 occurrence of certain reversions of appropriations made from the State General
14 Fund for projects of capital improvement approved during the 2017 and 2019
15 Legislative Sessions.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Section 6 of chapter 606, Statutes of Nevada 2017,
2 at page 4440, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 Sec. 6. The State Board of Finance shall issue general
4 obligation bonds of the State of Nevada in the face amount of
5 not more than \$117,912,005 for the capital improvements

18 contrary, upon approval of the Chief of the Budget Division of the
