SUMMARY—Revises the Charter of the City of North Las Vegas. (BDR S-5)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: May have Fiscal Impact. Effect on the State: No.

EXPLANATION - Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to the Charter of the City of North Las Vegas; increasing the number of wards in the City of North Las Vegas; increasing the number of Council Members of the City Council of the City of North Las Vegas; requiring the City Manager to conduct an annual diversity study and establish a supplier diversity program; setting forth residency requirements for the City Manager; revising the powers and duties of the City Attorney; requiring certain reports to the Legislature; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

#### Legislative Counsel's Digest:

The existing Charter of the City of North Las Vegas divides the City into four 123456789 wards, each of which is represented on the City Council by a Council Member. (North Las Vegas City Charter §§ 1.045, 2.010) Section 1 of this bill increases the number of wards in the City of North Las Vegas from four to six. Section 2 of this bill provides that the City Council of the City consists of six Council Members and a Mayor. Section 8 of this bill requires that the seats for the City Council Members be designated one through six. Section 10 of this bill requires, between July 1, 2023, and December 31, 2023, the City Council to, by ordinance: (1) establish the boundaries for the new fifth and sixth wards; and (2) change the boundaries of the 10 existing four wards so that the boundaries of all six wards are contiguous and as 11 nearly as equal in population as possible. Sections 7 and 11 of this bill provide that 12 13 the Council Members who represent the fifth and sixth wards will be first elected at the general municipal election held in November 2024, and the wards will not be 14 considered vacant before that election. Section 12 of this bill requires the City





15 Manager to present a report to the Joint Interim Standing Committee on Legislative 16 Operations and Elections during the legislative interim regarding the redistricting of 17 the wards.

18 Existing law requires the City Council to appoint a City Manager who need not 19 be a resident of the City or the State of Nevada at the time of his or her 20 appointment, but he or she may reside outside the City while in office only with the 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 approval of the City Council. (North Las Vegas City Charter § 3.010) Section 4 of this bill requires that the City Manager become an actual resident of the City not later than 6 months after the date of his or her appointment and remain a resident of the City while in office. Section 13 of this bill provides that if the City Manager is not an actual resident of the City on July 1, 2023, he or she must become an actual resident of the City not later than December 31, 2023, and remain a resident while in office.

Section 3 of this bill requires the City Manager to: (1) prepare an annual diversity study to determine the number of city employees who are in managerial positions and are women, veterans or members of a minority group; and (2) establish a supplier diversity program.

31 32 33 34 Section  $\hat{6}$  of this bill provides that the City Attorney or an attorney with whom the City Council enters into a contract to perform all or a portion of the duties of the City Attorney may not opine or provide legal advice to the Mayor or a Council 35 Member on any issue or matter that does not directly relate to the official duties of 36 the Mayor or the Council Member.

37 Section 9 of this bill requires the City Manager to submit a report to the Senate 38 Standing Committee on Government Affairs and the Assembly Standing 39 Committee on Government Affairs on vacant or leased space in the North Las 40 Vegas City Hall.

#### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY. DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Section 1.045 of the Charter of the City of North 2 Las Vegas, being chapter 344, Statutes of Nevada 1999, at page 3 1413, is hereby amended to read as follows:

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Wards: Creation; Boundaries. Sec. 1.045

The City must be divided into **[four]** six wards which 1. must be as nearly equal in population as practicable, and each of which must be composed entirely of contiguous territory.

2. The boundaries of the wards must be established and changed by ordinance. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, the boundaries of the wards must be changed whenever the population, as determined by the last preceding national census of the Bureau of the Census of the United States Department of Commerce, in any ward exceeds the population in any other ward by more than 5 percent.

3. The boundaries of the wards must not be changed, except to accommodate an annexation of territory to the City, during the period beginning 30 days immediately preceding the last day for filing a declaration of candidacy for a municipal election and ending on the date of the election.

33	6. The Mayor must be voted upon by the registered
34	voters of the City at large, and except as otherwise provided
35	in sections 5.010 and 5.100, his or her term of office is 4
36	years.
37	7. The Mayor and Council Members are entitled to
38	receive a salary in an amount fixed by the City Council.
39	Sec. 3. The Charter of the City of North Las Vegas, being
40	chapter 573, Statutes of Nevada 1971, at page 1210, is hereby
41	amended by adding thereto new sections to be designated as section
42	3.022 and 3.023, respectively, immediately following section 3.020,

1 Sec. 3.022 Diversity Studies. 2 On or before December 31 of each year, the City *I*. 3 Manager shall prepare a diversity study to determine the number of employees of each agency, bureau, board, 4 5 commission, department, division and other office of the 6 City who are in managerial positions and are women, 7 veterans or members of a minority group. 2. Each diversity study prepared pursuant to this 8 section must be posted in a prominent location on the 9 Internet website of the City. 10 The City Manager shall present the results of each 11 3. 12 diversity study at a public meeting to the City Council and 13 the Charter Committee. The City Council and Charter Committee shall consider the results of the diversity study in 14 15 determining whether to propose any amendment to this 16 Charter. 17 4. A diversity study prepared pursuant to this section 18 must not include any personally identifiable information of 19 any employee of the City. 20 5. The City Manager shall maintain the records, 21 documents and other materials used in the preparation of a 22 diversity study pursuant to this section in written or 23 electronic form for at least 10 years after the presentation of 24 the results of the diversity study pursuant to subsection 3. 6. As used in this section, "minority group" means: 25 26 (a) A racial or ethnic minority group; 27 (b) A group of persons with disabilities; or 28 (c) A group of persons who identify as LGBTQ. As used in this paragraph, "LGBTQ" means lesbian, gay, bisexual, 29 30 transgender, queer, intersex or any other nonheterosexual or noncisgender orientation or gender identity 31 or 32 expression. 33 Sec. 3.023 Supplier Diversity Program. The City Manager shall establish a supplier diversity 34 1. 35 program to ensure that businesses located in the City that 36 are owned by women, veterans or a member of a minority 37 group are made aware of the City's advertisements for bids 38 or requests for proposals.

2. The City Manager shall ensure that information about the supplier diversity program established pursuant to this section is prominently displayed on the Internet website of the City.

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3. On or before January 1 of each year, the City Manager shall prepare a report on the supplier diversity program that includes, without limitation:



- 1 (a) The number of contracts awarded by the City for the 2 previous calendar year to businesses located in the City that 3 are owned by women, veterans or a member of a minority 4 group; and 5 (b) The amount of money paid to businesses located in
  - (b) The amount of money paid to businesses located in the City that are owned by women, veterans or a member of a minority group pursuant to the contracts described in paragraph (a).
- 9 4. Each report must be prominently displayed on the 10 Internet website of the City.
- 115. The City Manager shall present the report prepared12pursuant to this section at a public meeting to the City13Council and the Charter Committee. The City Council and14Charter Committee shall consider the results of the report in15determining whether to propose any amendment to this16Charter.
- 6. The City Manager shall maintain the records,
  documents and other materials used in the preparation of a
  report pursuant to this section in written or electronic form
  for at least 10 years after the presentation of the report
  pursuant to subsection 5.
  - 7. As used in this section, "minority group" means:
  - (a) A racial or ethnic minority group;

30 **Sec. 4.** Section 3.010 of the Charter of the City of North Las 31 Vegas, being chapter 573, Statutes of Nevada 1971, at page 1219, is 32 hereby amended to read as follows:

- 33 Sec. 3.010 City Manager: Appointment and 34 qualifications; acting City Manager.
- 35 The City Council shall appoint a City Manager for an 1. 36 indefinite term and fix his or her compensation. The City 37 Manager shall be appointed on the basis of his or her 38 administrative qualifications. The City Manager need not be a 39 resident of the City for the State of Nevadal at the time of his or her appointment . [, but he or she may reside outside the 40 City while in office only with the approval of the City 41 42 **Council.**] The City Manager must become an actual resident of the City not later than 6 months after the date of his or 43 44 her appointment and remain a resident of the City while in 45 office.

By letter filed with the City Clerk, the City Manager 2 shall designate, subject to the approval of the City Council, a 3 qualified city administrative officer to exercise the powers 4 and perform the duties of the City Manager during his or her 5 temporary absence or disability. The City Council may 6 revoke such designation at any time. 7 Sec. 5. (Deleted by amendment.) 8 Sec. 6. Section 3.050 of the Charter of the City of North Las 9 Vegas, being chapter 573, Statutes of Nevada 1971, as last amended by chapter 254, Statutes of Nevada 2021, at page 1332, is hereby 10 amended to read as follows: 11 12 Sec. 3.050 City Attorney: Appointment; salary: 13 qualifications; duties; removal; contract in lieu of or in 14 addition to appointment. 15 Except as otherwise provided in subsection 6, the City 1. 16 Council shall appoint a City Attorney and fix his or her 17 salary. 18 2. The City Attorney and any attorney with whom the 19 City Council enters into a contract pursuant to subsection 6 20 must be a licensed member of the State Bar of Nevada. 21 [The] Except as otherwise provided in subsection 8, 3. 22 *the* City Attorney is the Chief Legal Officer of the City and 23 shall perform such duties as may be designated by the City 24 Council or prescribed by ordinance. 25 The City Attorney is under the general direction and 4. supervision of the City Council. 26 27 The City Attorney serves at the pleasure of the City 5. 28 Council and may be removed at any time in accordance with 29 the terms of the City Attorney's employment contract by an 30 affirmative vote of a majority of the entire membership of the 31 City Council. 32 In lieu of or in addition to appointing a City Attorney 6. 33 pursuant to subsection 1, the City Council may enter into a contract with one or more attorneys employed by or 34 35 associated with a professional corporation, partnership or limited-liability company that engages in the practice of law 36 37 in this State to perform all or a portion of the duties of the 38 City Attorney. If the City Council enters into such a contract, 39 the City Council shall ensure that the contract specifies the 40 duties to be performed and the compensation payable for the 41 performance of those duties. 42 An attorney with whom the City Council enters into a 7. 43 contract to perform all or a portion of the duties of the City 44 Attorney pursuant to subsection 6 has, for each of the duties 45 specified in the contract, all the powers and duties otherwise

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1 conferred upon a City Attorney who is appointed pursuant to 2 subsection 1. 3 The City Attorney or an attorney with whom the City 8. 4 Council enters into a contract to perform all or a portion of 5 the duties of the City Attorney pursuant to subsection 6 may 6 not opine or provide legal advice to the Mayor or a Council 7 Member on any issue or matter that does not directly relate 8 to the official duties of the Mayor or the Council Member. 9 Section 5.010 of the Charter of the City of North Las Sec. 7. Vegas, being chapter 573, Statutes of Nevada 1971, as last amended 10 by chapter 558, Statutes of Nevada 2019, at page 3562, is hereby 11 12 amended to read as follows: 13 Sec. 5.010 General municipal elections. 14 1. On the second Tuesday after the first Monday in June 15 2019, there must be elected, at a general municipal election to 16 be held for that purpose, two Council Members, who shall 17 hold office until their successors have been elected and 18 qualified pursuant to subsection 4. 19 On the first Tuesday after the first Monday in 2. 20 November 2022, and at each successive interval of 4 years 21 thereafter, there must be elected, at a general municipal 22 election to be held for that purpose, a Mayor and two Council 23 Members, who shall hold office for a period of 4 years and 24 until their successors have been elected and qualified. 25 3. On the first Tuesday after the first Monday in 26 November 2022, and at each successive interval of 6 years, 27 there must be elected, at a general municipal election to be 28 held for that purpose, a Municipal Judge who shall hold 29 office for a period of 6 years and until his or her successor 30 has been elected and qualified. 31 4. On the first Tuesday after the first Monday in 32 November 2024, and at each successive interval of 4 years 33 thereafter, there must be elected, at a general municipal 34 election to be held for that purpose, [two] four Council 35 Members who shall hold office for a period of 4 years and 36 until their successors have been elected and gualified. 37 5. In a general municipal election: 38 (a) A candidate for the office of City Council Member 39 must be elected only by the registered voters of the ward that 40 he or she seeks to represent. 41 (b) Candidates for all other elective offices must be 42 elected by the registered voters of the City at large. 43 Section 5.020 of the Charter of the City of North Las Sec. 8. 44 Vegas, being chapter 573, Statutes of Nevada 1971, as last amended





1 by chapter 558, Statutes of Nevada 2019, at page 3562, is hereby 2 amended to read as follows:

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Sec. 5.020 Primary municipal elections; declaration of candidacv.

5 The City Council shall provide by ordinance for 1. 6 candidates for elective office to declare their candidacy and 7 file the necessary documents. The seats for City Council 8 Members must be designated by the numbers one through 9 four, six, which numbers must correspond with the wards the candidates for City Council Members will seek to 10 represent. A candidate for the office of City Council Member 11 shall include in his or her declaration of candidacy the 12 13 number of the ward which he or she seeks to represent. Each 14 candidate for City Council must be designated as a candidate 15 for the City Council seat that corresponds with the ward that 16 he or she seeks to represent.

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A primary municipal election must be held: 2.

(a) On the Tuesday following the first Monday in April 2019; and

(b) Beginning in 2022, on the second Tuesday in June of each even-numbered year.

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3. In the primary municipal election:

(a) A candidate for the office of City Council Member must be voted upon only by the registered voters of the ward that he or she seeks to represent.

(b) Candidates for all other elective offices must be voted 26 27 upon by the registered voters of the City at large.

Except as otherwise provided in subsection 5, after 4. the primary municipal election, the names of the two candidates who receive the highest number of votes must be placed on the ballot for the general municipal election.

If, regardless of the number of candidates for an 5. office, one candidate receives a majority of the total votes cast for that office in the primary municipal election, he or she must be declared elected to that office and no general municipal election need be held for that office.

37 Sec. 9. On or before May 1, 2023, the City Manager of the 38 City of North Las Vegas shall submit a report to the Senate Standing 39 Committee on Government Affairs and the Assembly Standing 40 Committee on Government Affairs regarding any space in the North 41 Las Vegas City Hall that is vacant or leased. The report must 42 include:

43 An identification on the floor plan of the North Las Vegas 1. 44 City Hall of each vacant or leased space. 45

2. The square footage of each such vacant or leased space.





1 3. For each such leased space, the dates of the commencement 2 and termination of the lease.

3 **Sec. 10.** Between July 1, 2023, and December 31, 2023, the 4 City Council must, by ordinance:

5 1. Establish the boundaries for the fifth and sixth wards created 6 by the provisions of section 1.045 of the Charter of the City of 7 North Las Vegas, as amended by section 1 of this act; and

8 2. Change the boundaries of the existing four wards so that the 9 boundaries of all six wards created pursuant to section 1.045 of the 10 Charter of the City of North Las Vegas, as amended by section 1 of 11 this act, are contiguous and as nearly as equal in population as 12 possible.

**Sec. 11.** The fifth and sixth wards created by the provisions of section 1.045 of the Charter of the City of North Las Vegas, as amended by section 1 of this act, must be filled initially at the general municipal election held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November 2024, provided for by section 5.010 of the Charter of the City of North Las Vegas, as amended by section 7 of this act, and shall not be deemed to be vacant before that time.

20 Sec. 12. 1. On or before June 1, 2024, the City Manager of 21 the City of North Las Vegas shall present a report to the Joint 22 Interim Standing Committee on Legislative Operations and 23 Elections regarding:

(a) Establishing the boundaries for the fifth and sixth wards
created by the provisions of section 1.045 of the Charter of the City
of North Las Vegas, as amended by section 1 of this act; and

(b) Changing the boundaries of the existing four wards so that
the boundaries of all six wards created pursuant to section 1.045 of
the Charter of the City of North Las Vegas, as amended by section 1
of this act, are contiguous and as nearly as equal in population as
possible.

2. The report presented pursuant to subsection 1 must include
the sources of funding used to pay for carrying out the provisions of
paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection 1 and an itemization of the
expenditures made from that funding.

**Sec. 13.** Notwithstanding the provisions of section 3.010 of the Charter of the City of North Las Vegas, as amended by section 4 of this act, if the City Manager is not an actual resident of the City on July 1, 2023, he or she must become an actual resident of the City not later than December 31, 2023, and remain a resident while in office.

42 **Sec. 14.** The provisions of NRS 354.599 do not apply to any 43 additional expenses of a local government that are related to the 44 provisions of this act.





1 **Sec. 15.** 1. This section and sections 9 and 14 of this act 2 become effective upon passage and approval.

3 2. Sections 1, 2, 7, 8, 10, 11 and 12 of this act become 4 effective:

5 (a) Upon passage and approval for the purpose of adopting ordinances, establishing the boundaries of the additional wards 6 7 created by the provisions of section 1.045 of the Charter of the City of North Las Vegas, as amended by section 1 of this act, changing 8 9 the boundaries of the first through fourth wards to comply with the provisions of section 1.045 of the Charter of the City of North Las 10 11 Vegas, as amended by section 1 of this act, and performing any preparatory administrative tasks that are necessary to carry out the 12 13 provisions of this act; and

14 (b) On January 1, 2024, for all other purposes.

15 3. Sections 3 to 6, inclusive, and 13 of this act become 16 effective on July 1, 2023.

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
