SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to the process for filling a vacancy in a board of county commissioners. (BDR 20-393)

AN ACT relating to counties; authorizing a board of county commissioners to establish a process for filling a vacancy in the board; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

#### **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Existing law requires that: (1) any vacancy occurring in any board of county commissioners must be filled by appointment of the Governor; and (2) the Governor's appointee must, with certain exceptions, be a member of the same political party as the most recent holder of the vacant office. (NRS 244.040) This bill authorizes a board of county commissioners to establish by ordinance a process for filling a vacancy on the board. If a board of county commissioners has not established such a process by ordinance, the Governor must, with certain exceptions, fill the vacancy by appointment with a person who is a member of the same political party as the most recent holder of the vacant office.

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** NRS 244.040 is hereby amended to read as follows: 244.040 1. [Any] Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, any vacancy occurring in any board of county commissioners must be filled by appointment of the Governor. Except in Carson City, the Governor shall appoint a suitable person

who is a member of the same political party as the most recent holder of the vacant office.

- 2. A board of county commissioners may establish by ordinance a process for filling any vacancy occurring in the board. If a board of county commissioners has not established such a process by ordinance, a vacancy occurring in the board must be filled by the Governor pursuant to subsection 1.
- 3. The term of office of a person [appointed to] who fills a vacancy in the office of county commissioner does not, by virtue of the appointment, extend beyond 12 p.m. of the day preceding the first Monday of January next following the next general election.
