SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to state financial administration. (BDR 31-806)

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EXPLANATION – Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to state financial administration; authorizing the Interim Finance Committee to grant provisional approval to a grant acceptance proposal or work program revision under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Under existing law, before revising certain work programs or accepting certain
2 grants an agency must submit a request to the Interim Finance Committee for
3 approval. The Interim Finance Committee has 45 days to make a decision regarding
4 the proposal. If no action is taken in this time, the proposed revision or acceptance
5 is deemed approved. (NRS 353.220, 353.335) This bill authorizes the Interim
6 Finance Committee to grant provisional approval to a proposed acceptance for a
7 federal grant or work program revision resulting from the federal grant before the
8 grant is awarded under certain circumstances. This bill also provides that if the
9 agency receives the grant, the agency is deemed to have received final approval
10 from the Interim Finance Committee to accept the grant and revise the appropriate
11 work program under certain circumstances.

1 **Sec. 3.** Chapter 353 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 1. *If a state agency submits an application for a federal grant*
4 *of property or services, the Interim Finance Committee may grant*
5 *the state agency provisional approval:*

6 (a) *For a revision to the appropriate work program pursuant to*
7 *NRS 353.220; and*

8 (b) *To accept the grant of property or services pursuant to*
9 *NRS 353.335.*

10 2. *A state agency that receives provisional approval from the*
11 *Interim Finance Committee pursuant to subsection 1 and is*
12 *awarded the federal grant:*

13 (a) *Shall be deemed to have received approval from the*
14 *Interim Finance Committee to:*

15 (1) *Revise the appropriate work program pursuant to NRS*
16 *353.220 if the actual revision to the work program as a result of*
17 *accepting the grant is an amount that does not exceed 10 percent*
18 *or \$75,000, whichever is more, of the amount that the Interim*
19 *Finance Committee approved pursuant to subsection 1.*

20 (2) *Accept the grant pursuant to NRS 353.335 if the*
21 *amount of the grant that is awarded to the state agency does not*
22 *exceed 10 percent or \$75,000, whichever is more, of the amount*
23 *that the Interim Finance Committee approved pursuant to*
24 *subsection 1.*

25 (b) *Must apply for approval from the Interim Finance*
26 *Committee to:*

27 (1) *Revise the appropriate work program pursuant to NRS*
28 *353.220 if the actual revision to the work program as a result of*
29 *accepting the grant is an amount that exceeds 10 percent or*
30 *\$75,000, whichever is more, of the amount that the Interim*
31 *Finance Committee approved pursuant to subsection 1.*

32 (2) *Accept the grant pursuant to NRS 353.335 if the*
33 *amount of the grant that is awarded to the state agency exceeds 10*
34 *percent or \$75,000, whichever is more, of the amount that the*
35 *Interim Finance Committee approved pursuant to subsection 1.*
