## SENATE BILL NO. 308–SENATOR ROBERSON

## MARCH 16, 2015

## SUMMARY—Provides funding for certain public works projects. (BDR S-764)

AN ACT relating to public works; making an appropriation to the State Public Works Board to fund certain public works projects; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The Legislature hereby finds and declares that:

The recession in this State which began in 2007 has limited
 the ability of the State to provide the necessary funding for the
 repair and maintenance of the infrastructure of this State, including
 many state-owned facilities, which are vital to the continued success
 of this State;

7 2. The State Public Works Board continues to evaluate and 8 assess the needs of this State and prioritize the list of the most 9 critical public works projects that are in need of such funding;

3. For the preceding three biennial budget cycles, the amount of money available for necessary public works projects relating to the infrastructure of this State has been considerably less than the amount needed to perform the needed maintenance, repairs or upgrades;

4. As a result of several years of shortages in funding for such public works projects, the amount necessary to complete such projects continues to grow due to increases in the costs for



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maintenance, repairs or upgrades to state-owned facilities due to the
aging, failure or disrepair of such facilities; and

5. If left unaddressed, the State may be forced to close, or severely restrict the use of, many state-owned facilities until such time as the necessary maintenance or repairs are performed, which then increases the eventual cost of subsequent maintenance, repairs or upgrades to such facilities.

8 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the State General 9 Fund to the State Public Works Board the sum of \$6,000,000 for 10 addressing critical infrastructure needs of the State.

Sec. 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by 11 12 section 2 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after 13 June 30, 2019, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or 14 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose 15 16 after September 20, 2019, by either the entity to which the money 17 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently 18 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General 19 Fund on or before September 20, 2019. 20

21 Sec. 4. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
