SUMMARY—Authorizes the Nevada System of Higher Education to impose additional restrictions relating to the use of tobacco. (BDR 15-873)

AN ACT relating to tobacco; authorizing the Nevada System of Higher Education to impose additional restrictions relating to the use of tobacco; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law imposes various restrictions on the use, sale and distribution of tobacco in certain places. (NRS 202.2485-202.2497) Under existing law, a school district is authorized to impose, with respect to the property, buildings, facilities and vehicles of the school district, more stringent restrictions on the smoking, use, sale, distribution, marketing, display or promotion of tobacco than are provided by certain other statutory provisions. (NRS 202.249) This bill similarly authorizes the Nevada System of Higher Education to impose more stringent restrictions relating to tobacco.





THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. NRS 202.249 is hereby amended to read as follows: 2 202.249 1. It is the public policy of the State of Nevada and 3 the purpose of NRS 202.2491, 202.24915 and 202.2492 to place 4 restrictions on the smoking of tobacco in public places to protect 5 human health and safety.

2. The quality of air is declared to be affected with the public
interest and NRS 202.2491, 202.24915 and 202.2492 are enacted in
the exercise of the police power of this state to protect the health,
peace, safety and general welfare of its people.

3. Health authorities, police officers of cities or towns, sheriffs and their deputies and other peace officers of this state shall, within their respective jurisdictions, enforce the provisions of NRS 202.2491, 202.24915 and 202.2492. Police officers of cities or towns, sheriffs and their deputies and other peace officers of this state shall, within their respective jurisdictions, enforce the provisions of NRS 202.2493, 202.24935 and 202.2494.

4. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 5, an agency, 17 18 board, commission or political subdivision of this state, including, 19 without limitation, any agency, board, commission or governing body of a local government, shall not impose more stringent 20 restrictions on the smoking, use, sale, distribution, marketing, 21 22 display or promotion of tobacco or products made or derived from tobacco than are provided by NRS 202.2491, 202.24915, 202.2492, 23 202.2493, 202.24935 and 202.2494. 24

[A school district may, with] With respect to the property, buildings, facilities and vehicles of [the] a school district $\frac{1}{11}$ or any 26 component of the Nevada System of Higher Education, the school 27 district or the System, as applicable, may impose more stringent 28 restrictions on the smoking, use, sale, distribution, marketing, 29 display or promotion of tobacco or products made or derived from 30 tobacco than are provided by NRS 202.2491, 202.24915, 202.2492, 31 32 202.2493, 202.24935 and 202.2494.
